



CY1356 SILCARESS DK WOODLAND WRAP

Materials

4 mm Crochet hook

3 x 100g balls of Silcaress DK shade Apple 2956

Darning needle

A 6" piece of cardboard to make tassels.

Pattern Notes

UK terminology used

Turning chain 3 counts as the 1st treble crochet of the row

Turning chain 1 does not count as a stitch.

tr– treble crochet sk – skip t – turn your work

dc – double crochet tur – turning fo – fasten off yarn

ch(s) - chain(s) ch(s) - chain(s) nxt - next

Ch 56

Row 1 - dc into 2nd ch from hook, * ch 5, sk 5 chs, 3 tr into nxt ch, ch 5, sk 5 chs, dc into nxt ch *, rept * to * 3 more times, ch 5, sk 5 chs, 2 tr into last ch

Row 2 - ch 3 (counts as 1st tr), t, into nxt tr work 3 tr, * ch 3, tr into dc, ch 3, into 1st tr of 3 work 3 tr, into nxt tr work 1 tr, into nxt tr work 3 tr * rept from * to * 3 more times, ch 3, tr into dc

Row 3 - ch 5, t, * into 1st tr of 7 work 3 tr, tr into nxt 5 tr, into last tr work 3 tr, ch 1 *, rept * to * 3 more times, 3 tr into nxt tr, tr into nxt 2 tr, tr into top of ch 3

Row 4 - ch 1, t, dc, * ch 5, into the ch 1 sp work 3 tr, ch 5, sk 5 tr, dc into nxt tr *, rept * to * 3 more times, ch 5, 2 tr into 5th ch


Row 5 - rept row 2

Row 6 - rept row 3

Row 7 - rept row 4

Repeat rows 2 till 7 until you have used 2 balls, ending on row 3.

Fasten off and make 20 tassels.




To make tassels

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6" in height
- Cut 2 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 25 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the center and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal

- Tie tightly about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the center to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top to attach
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the center to blend them in
- Trim Neatly

Attach tassels spaced evenly across both edges.





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
