



CY1224 BABY PATO DK SCALLOP DRESS AND BONNET NEWBORN

Materials -

Baby Pato DK shade Candy 797

2 x 100g

Tension

22sts / 30 rows = 10cm (4")

5 and 4 mm Crochet Hooks

Darning Needle

Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used

The numbers at the end of each round in Brackets, are the amount of Stitches you should have at the end of that row.

The CH 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st Stitch of the Row unless otherwise stated

Abbreviations -

TC - Treble Crochet

DC – Double Crochet

CH - Chain

SS - Slip Stitch

REP - Repeat

ST - stitch

REM - Remaining

T - Turn your work

NXT - Next

SHELL - 2 TC + CH 1 + 2 TC all in the same Stitch

SP - Space

INC - Increase 3 x TC in the same Stitch

Pattern

Yoke Section

CH – 60 / SS to join ring

Row 1 – CH 1 / DC AROUND

(60)

Row 2 - CH 1 / TC 7 / INC / TC 14 / INC / TC 14 / INC / TC 14 / INC / TC 7 / SS TO 1ST ST

Row 3 - CH 1 / TC 8 / INC / TC 16 / INC / TC 16 / INC / TC 16 / INC / TC 8 / SS TO 1ST ST

Row 4 – CH 1 / DC / SHELL / DC / HTC / SHELL / DC / HTC / SHELL / DC / INC / ** DC / SHELL / DC / HTC / SHELL / DC / HTC / SHELL / DC / INC **

REP from ** to ** Twice more / DC / SHELL / DC / HTC / SHELL / DC / HTC / SHELL / SS to 1st ST

Separating for Sleeves

Row 5 -

Tip: If you are struggling to find the 1st ST to work into on the shell, count 2 to the right from the CH 1

** CH 1 TC / Place 1 TC in the top of the NXT 5 STS (1 each in the 1st 2 STS of the SHELL, 1 in the CH 1 SP, 1 each in the last 2 STS of the SHELL / HTC in the DC from the row Before / SK the HTC**

REP from ** to ** 3 times /

((Sleeve - TC in the Centre ST on the INC / SK to the NXT centre ST INC / TC))

REP from ** to ** for the NXT 6 SHELLS / REP from ((to)) for the NXT Sleeve

REP From ** to ** for the last 3 SHELLS

Row 6 - CH 1 / HTC Across

(73)

Row 7 - CH 1 / HTC Across (73)

Row 8 - CH 1 / ** 2 x HTD / 1 HTC in the NXT 6 STS ** / REP from ** to ** Until you have 3 STS left / 2 x HTC / 1 HTC in the last 2 (83)

Row 9 - CH 1 / TC ACROSS (83)

Row 10 - CH 1 / SHELL / SK 1 / DC / SK 1 / REP around / SS in 1st ST (21 Shells)

Row 11 – SS into CH 1 / DC / SHELL IN DC / DC IN THE CH 1 SP / REP around / SS in the 1st DC

Row 12 - CH 1 / SHELL IN THE DC / DC IN THE CH 1 / REP around / SS in the 1st TC

Rep Row 11 - 7 more times

Rep Row 12 - 6 more times, or until you reach the Desired length

For the Final Row Repeat as before but place 5 TC instead of a Shell

Finish Off, Weave in Ends.

Bonnet

Hat -

Row 1 - CH 1 / 10 TC into MR / SS to 1st ST (10)

Row 2 - CH 1 / 2 x TC / 1 TC in the NXT 1 / REP around / SS to 1st ST (20)

Row 3 - CH 1 / 2 x TC / 1 TC in the NXT 2 / REP around / SS to 1st ST (30)

Row 4 - CH 1 / 2 x TC / 1 TC in the NXT 3 / REP around / SS to 1st ST (40)

Row 5 – CH 1 / DC around / SS (40)

Rows 6 – 10 – CH 1 / TC 36 / Leave the last 4 STS Unworked CH 1 / T (36)

Row 11 – DC across (36)

For Row 12 when it says SHELL, work 4 TC into the same ST

Row 12 – CH 1 / T / SK 1 / ** SHELL / SK 1 / DC / SK 1 ** REP from ** to ** for a total of 9 Shells / DC in last ST

Ties –

Using a 4 mm hook, CH 60 / cut yarn and attach to opposite side / CH 60

Finish Off, Weave in Ends.



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
