



CY1341 Pato Baby DK  
Fruity Cardigans

**Materials:**

1 x 100g ball Pato Baby DK pictured shades Mint 790 & Apricot 784

4.5 mm hook

12 mm wooden button

**Notes**

UK terminology used

The chain 1 at the beginning of the row does not count as a stitch.

Work straight back down into the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch unless otherwise stated.

The amount in brackets ( ) is the number of stitches or pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

Gauge – on the yoke with a 4.5mm hook – 12 htc and 10 rows to 4" (10cm)

**Approximate finished sizes**

Newborn to 1 month - 19" chest, 7" sleeve, 10" Length

3 to 6 months – 21.5" chest, 8" sleeve, 11" Length

Abbreviations -

tc – treble crochet

dc – double crochet

htc – half treble

crochet

ch(s) – chain(s)

Inc - 3 half treble

crochet into nxt chain

or space

slst – slip stitch

t – turn

rept – repeat

fo – fasten off yarn

**Newborn to 1 month**

Ch 42

Row 1 - into 2nd ch htc, htc 5, inc, htc 6, inc, htc 13, inc, htc 6, inc, htc 6

Row 2 - ch 1, t, htc 7, inc, htc 8, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 8, inc, htc 7

Row 3 - ch 1, t, htc 8, inc, htc 10, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 10, inc, htc 8

Row 4 - ch 1, t, htc 9, inc, htc 12, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 12, inc, htc 9

Row 5 - ch 1, t, htc 10, inc, htc 14, inc, htc 21, inc, htc 14, inc, htc 10

Row 6 - ch 1, t, htc 11, inc, htc 16, inc, htc 23, inc, htc 16, inc, htc 11

Row 7 - ch 1, t, htc 12, inc, htc 18, inc, htc 25, inc, htc 18, inc, htc 12

**Separating for sleeves**

Row 8 – ch 1, t, htc 14, ch 1, sk 20, htc 29, ch 1, sk 20, htc 14

Row 9 – ch 1, t, htc across the 14 htc + 1 ch + 29 htc + 1 ch + htc 14

## Body

Row 10 – ch 1, t, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*sk 1, sc + dc into nxt rept from \* across (30)

Row 11 – ch1, t, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> dc, \*dc + tc into nxt dc, rept from \* across

Rows 12 to 23 – rept row 11

## Button bands

Work on right for boys and left for girls

Attach at bottom corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc into every dc to the bottom, fo

Work on left for boys and right for girls

Attach at bottom corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, ch 1, sk 1, dc into every dc to bottom, fo

## Sleeves

Attach under arm, and working on the sts skipped in row 8

Row 1 – ch 1, htc 22, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htc

Row 2 – ch 1, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*sk 1, dc + tc into nxt, rept from \* around, slst to 1st dc (11)

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> dc, \* dc + tc into nxt dc, rept from \* around, slst to 1st dc

Rows 4 till 10 - rept row 3, fo

Repeat for other sleeve.

Whip stitch closed the small gaps under the arms, sew on button and weave in all ends.

## 3 to 6 months

Ch 48

Row 1 - into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch htc, htc 6, inc, htc 7, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 7, inc, htc 7 (47)

Row 2 - ch 1, t, htc 8, inc, htc 9, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 9, inc, htc 8

Row 3 - ch 1, t, htc 9, inc, htc 11, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 11, inc, htc 9

Row 4 - ch 1, t, htc 10, inc, htc 13, inc, htc 21, inc, htc 13, inc, htc 10

Row 5 - ch 1, t, htc 11, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 23, inc, htc 15, inc, htc 11

Row 6 - ch 1, t, htc 12, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 25, inc, htc 17, inc, htc 12

Row 7 - ch 1, t, htc 13, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 27, inc, htc 19, inc, htc 13

Row 8 – ch 1, t, htc 14, inc, htc 21, inc, htc 29, inc, htc 21, inc, htc, 14

### **Separating for sleeves**

Row 9 – ch 1, t, htc 16, ch 1, sk 23, htc 33, ch 1, sk 23, htc 16

Row 10 – ch 1, t, htc across the 16 htc + 1 ch + 33 htc + 1 ch + 16 htc (67)

### **Body**

Row 11 – ch 1, t, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*sk 1, dc + tc into nxt rept from \* across (33)

Row 12 – ch1, t, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> dc , \*dc + tc into nxt dc, rept from \* across

Rows 13 to 26 – rept row 12

### **Button bands**

Work on right for boys and left for girls

Attach at bottom corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc into every dc to the bottom, fo

Work on left for boys and right for girls

Attach at bottom corner

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to the top

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, ch 1, sk 1 ,dc into every dc to bottom, fo

### **Sleeves**

Attach under arm, and working on the sts skipped in row 9

Row 1 – ch 1, htc 24, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htc

Row 2 – ch 1, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*sk 1, dc + tc into nxt, rept from \* around, slst to 1st dc (12)

Rows 3 till 12 - ch 1, t, dc + tc into 1<sup>st</sup> dc, \* dc + tc into nxt dc, rept from \* around, slst to 1st dc

Repeat for other sleeve.

Whip stitch closed the small gaps under the arms, sew on button and weave in all ends.



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
