

CY1274 CYGNET CHUNKY TEXTURED COWL IN 3 SIZES

You Will need -

Cygnet Chunky Shade Red 167 1 x 100g ball for the child, 2 x 100g balls for teen and adult

2 x 4 cm ribbons

6 mm crochet hook

Darning needle

Pattern Notes

UK terminology used

The numbers at the end of each round in brackets, are the amount of stitches you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.

The chain 3 at the beginning of the round counts as a treble crochet.

Abbreviations –
tc – treble crochet
htc – half treble crochet
dc – double crochet
fpdc – front post double crochet
bet – between
ch - chain
slst - slip stitch
rept - repeat
st(s)- stitch(s)
rem - remaining
t - turn your work
nxt - next
sp(s) – space(s)

Small (6-8 years)

Ch 22

Row $1 - in 2^{nd}$ ch htc, htc into each ch

Row 2 – ch3, t, 2 x tc into base of ch, ** sk3, work dc + ch 3 + 3 x tc into nxt st, rept from ** till last st, dc into last st

Row 3 – ch 3, t, 2 x tc into base of ch, around the 3^{rd} tc of the 3, work a fpdc, ch3 then 3 x tc around the ch3 from the row before, rept till last st, dc into 3^{rd} ch of turning ch (3 x tc + 4 groups)

Rept row 3 until you have a comfortable fit, leaving a long tail for sewing

Medium (teen)

Ch 26

Row $1 - in 2^{nd}$ ch htc, htc into each ch

Row 2 – ch3, t, 2 x tc into base of ch, ** sk3, work dc + ch 3 + 3 x tc into nxt st, rept from ** till last st, dc into last st

Row 3 - ch 3, t, 2 x tc into base of ch, around the 3^{rd} tc of the 3, work a fpdc, ch3 then 3 x tc around the ch3 from the row before, rept till last st, dc into 3^{rd} ch of turning ch (3 x tc + 5 groups)

Rept row 3 until you have a comfortable fit, leaving a long tail for sewing

Large (adult)

Row 2 – ch3, t, 2 x tc into base of ch, ** sk3, work dc + ch 3 + 3 x tc into nxt st, rept from ** till last st, dc into last st

Row 3 - ch 3, t, 2 x tc into base of ch, around the 3^{rd} tc of the 3, work a fpdc, ch3 then 3 x tc around the ch3 from the row before, rept till last st, dc into 3^{rd} ch of turning ch (3 x tc + 6 groups)

Rept row 3 until you have a comfortable fit, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Making up -

With the right side facing lay your cowl on a surface and fold over as shown.

Place markers on the 4 corners of the outlined square.

Going through both layers, stitch all the way around the square to attach, being careful not to catch the back section

Weave in all ends and sew on ribbons along the seam.
