



Little Rainbow Ruffles Blanket

Measurements Size: approx. 92 x 70cm	
Materials	
6x 100g Silcaress DK White 2080	1x 100g Silcaress DK Raspberry 2278
1x 100g Silcaress DK Fondant 2837	1x 100g Silcaress DK Clementine 2093
1x 100g Silcaress DK Buttercup 2887	1x 100g Silcaress DK Apple 2956
1x 100g Silcaress DK Cornflower 2119	1x 100g Silcaress DK Sherbert 2723
5mm crochet hook (base of the blanket)	4mm crochet hook (rainbow ruffles)
Tapestry needle	Scissors

Helpful notes

- Blanket can be made to desired size, simply by adding or decreasing the number of stitches of your starting chain for the width of your blanket and adding or decreasing the number of rows for the length of your blanket.
- Once you have your white base and are starting with your ruffles you might find it easier to fold the blanket, this way the back loops sit nicely for you to work in and it's much easier to catch the loop as you work along.
- When starting your ruffles, sew in your ends as you go.
- For the ruffles you will be working right to left along your blanket.

Abbreviations

ch – chain	htc - half treble crochet
tr - treble crochet	sl st - slip stitch
blo - back loop only	flo – front loop only
Tension	
15 stitches x 7 rows (4 inch square)	

PATTERN

White Base

<u>To start</u>	*Repeat until you get to your desired length (I did 52 rows for a baby blanket)
You will use 2 balls of yarn for the base to make it extra squishy!	Ruffles
With 2 strands of yarn start by ch 110 plus 2 ch for turning (112 ch)	Once you have your white base, start by tying on your first colour to secure
	ch 2
Dow 1 52	4 htr into each loop
Row 1-52 3 rd ch from the hook tr back along your work	ss at the end to fasten off ruffle
*ch 2 and turn	Continue making ruffles in each front loop on each row
*working in blo tr along your work	<u>To finish</u>
	Sew in your ends with a tapestry needle and snuggle!
