



## CY1734 CYGNET BABY COLOUR SOFT V STITCH BABY BLANKET

### **Materials –**

4.5mm crochet hook

2 balls of Cygnet Baby Colour Soft DK in Rose Burst 552

1 ball of Everyday Pato DK in White 999

### **Pattern notes –**

UK terminology used

The starting chain multiple for this blanket is any even number.

The turning chain 1 does not count as a stitch.

The turning chain 3 counts as the 1<sup>st</sup> treble crochet of the row.

Vst – work 1 treble crochet + chain 1 + 1 treble crochet all into the same stitch or space.

The blanket shown had a starting chain on 110 and will give you a toddlers sized lap blanket,

## Abbreviations -

tr – treble crochet	bphtcr – back post half treble crochet	st(s) – stitch(s)	fo – fasten off yarn
htr – half treble crochet	vst – v stitch	tur – turning	nxt – next
fphtcr – front post half treble crochet	ch(s) – chain(s)	cl(s) – cluster(s)	bet – between
	sk – skip	vst – v stitch	sp(s) – space(s)
		t – turn your work	

Starting with Baby Colour Soft, make your starting chain

Row 1 – vst into the 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, sk 2, \* vst into nxt, sk 2, rept from \* till last stitch, tr into last (36 vst)

Row 2 – ch 3, t, \* into the ch 1 of each vst, work a vst, rept from \* across ending with a tr into last st

Repeat row 2 until you reach your desired length, fo the Colour Soft and attach the Everyday Pato.

Row 1 – ch 1, htr evenly all the way around, placing 1 htr into each of the tr sts and ch 1 sps. When working down the sides place 2 htr around each ch 3 and tr, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 2 – ch 1, fphtcr into 1<sup>st</sup>, \* bphtcr into nxt, fphtcr into nxt, rept all the way around, ending on a bphtcr, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st.

Rows 3 to 5 – ch 1, \*fphtcr into fphtcr, bphtcr into bphtcr, rept all the way around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.



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
