Materials

1 x 100g Cygnet DK Red 1206 (MC) 1 x 100g Cygnet DK White 208 (CC1) 1 x 100g Cygnet DK Sunshine 184 (CC2)

4mm Crochet Hook

Safety Toy stuffing

Emergency foil blanket to be used to make the crinkle noise 5x circular sheets 20cm in diameter Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

Tension

Tension is not important aslong as you maintain the same tension throughout.

Sizing

Approx. 11 cm tall, and 25cm wide.

Rnd 20: *dc into next eighteen sts, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (160sts) Rnd 21: Working into the front of the loop for this row only, dc in to each st. Rnd 22: Dc into each st. Rnd 23: Work into the back of the loop only for this row, dc into each st. Rnd 24: Dc into each st. Rnd 25: Working through the stitches of the previous row and the back of the stitches from row 21, Dc around. This will create the lip for the top of the drum. Rnd 26: Dc into each st. Change to MC. Rnds 27-44: Dc into each st. Change to CC2. Rnds 44-47: Dc into each st. Rnd 48: *dc into next eighteen sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (152sts) Rnd 49: *dc into next seventeen sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (144sts) Line the bottom of the drum with the foil. Stuff and continue stuffing as you go. Rnd 50: *dc into next sixteen sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (136sts) Rnd 51: *dc into next fifteen sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd.

dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (120sts) Rnd 53: *dc into next thirteen sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (112sts) Rnd 54: *dc into next twelve sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (104sts) Rnd 55: *dc into next eleven sts. dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (96sts) Rnd 56: *dc into next ten sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (88sts) Rnd 57: *dc into next nine sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (80sts) Rnd 58: *dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (72sts) Rnd 59: *dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (64sts) Rnd 60: *dc into next six sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (56sts) Rnd 61: *dc into next five sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (48sts) Rnd 62: *dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (40sts) Rnd 63: *dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 52: *dc into next fourteen sts.

(32sts) Rnd 64: *dc into next two sts, (24sts) Rnd 65: *dc into next st, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (16sts)



Rnd 66: *dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (8sts) Thread yarn through stitches and pull tight.

Gold Studs

Make 8. With 4mm hook and CC2. Rnd 1: ch2, 6dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts) Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts) Rnd 3: *dc, 2dc into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (18sts) Rnds 4-6: Dc into each st. Rnd 7: *dc, dc2tog into next st; rep from * to end of rnd. (12sts) Stuff and continue to stuff as you go. Rnd 8: *dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (6sts) Thread yarn through stitches and pull tight to close.

Zigzag Detail

With 4mm hook and CC1. Ch224. Fasten off.

To Make Up

Attach the length of chain in a zigzag pattern around the drum using the increase/decrease points as a guide, attaching the chain at these points alternatively.

Attach the gold studs at the zigzag points.



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
