NEWBORN CHRISTMAS DRESS AND BOOTIES

## Materials –

3 x 100g balls of Cygnet Dk

4.5 mm crochet hook

## Pattern notes –

Yarn A – White 208

Yarn B – Red 1206

Yarn C – Emerald 377

UK terminology used

## Abbreviations explained -

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch

V stitch – work 1 treble crochet + chain 1 + 1 treble crochet into the same stitch or space.

Puff stitch – [yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop] 3 times, yarn over pull through all 7 loops, chain 1 to close

Puff stitch corner - work 1 puff stitch + chain 1 + 1 puff stitch all into the same stitch or space.

From row 3 to 6 when working the increase rows, work into the top of the puff stitch, but **not** into the chain 1 stitch that closes the puff stitch.

From row 3 to row 5 work the puff stitch corners into the center chain 1 space from the row before.

## Dress –

With yarn A ch 61

Row 1 – htr into 2<sup>nd</sup>  
ch from hook, htr into

each ch across

(60)

Row 2 – ch 1, t, tr 7,  
psc, tr 14, psc, tr 14,  
psc, tr 14, psc, tr 7

Row 3 – ch 1, t, tr 8,  
psc, tr 16, psc, tr 16,

psc, tr 16, psc, tr 8,  
slst to the 1<sup>st</sup> st to  
join

Row 4 – ch 1, t, tr 9,  
psc, tr 18, psc, tr 18,  
psc, tr 18, psc, tr 9,  
slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 5 – ch 1, t, tr  
10, psc, tr 20, psc, tr  
20, psc, tr 20, psc, tr  
10, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

### **Separating for sleeves –**

Row 6 - Ch 1, don't t,  
tr 10, tr into ps, tr into  
ch 1, ch 1, sk to nxt  
ch 1 cor sp, tr into ch  
1 cor sp, tr into ps, tr  
20, tr into ps, tr into  
ch 1, ch 1, sk to nxt  
ch 1 cor sp, tr into ch  
1 cor sp, tr into ps, tr  
10, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

### **Skirt –**

Row 7 – ch 1, and  
htr across all the  
stitches including the  
2 ch 1 sps, slst to 1<sup>st</sup>  
st, fo A (50)

Row 8 – with yarn B  
and right side facing  
, ch 1, tr into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*  
vst into nxt, tr into  
nxt, rept from \*  
around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st,  
fo B (25 tr and 25

vsts)

Row 9 – attach yarn  
C into the 1<sup>st</sup> tr, ch 1,  
\* fptr around the tr,  
vst into the ch 1 sp of  
the vst, rept from \*  
around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st,  
fo C and attach A  
Rept row 9 until you  
have worked a total  
of 17 vst rows,  
changing colour after  
every row.

### **Shell trim –**

With yarn A work as  
row 9 but work 4 tr  
into the vst instead.  
Fasten off weave in  
all ends and sew on  
small button at the  
neck opening.

### **Booties –**

With yarn A ch 12  
Row 1 – dc into 2<sup>nd</sup>  
ch from hook, dc 9, 4  
x dc into last ch,  
working along the  
opposite side, dc 10,

slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st (24)

Row 2 – ch 1, 2 dc  
into nxt st twice, dc  
7, 2 x htr into nxt st 6  
times, dc 7, 2 dc into  
nxt st twice, slst to 1<sup>st</sup>  
st (34)

Row 3 – ch 1, htr 14,  
2 x htr into nxt st 6  
times, htr 14, slst to  
1<sup>st</sup> st (40)

Row 4 – ch 1, htrbl  
into each st around,  
slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 5 – ch 1, htr into  
each st around, slst  
to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 6 – ch 1, htr 13,  
htr2tog 8 times, htr  
11, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st (32)

Row 7 – ch 1, htr 10,  
htr2tog 7 times, htr 8,  
slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st (25)

Row 8 – ch 1, htr 9,  
htr2tog 5 times, htr 6,  
slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo A (20)

Row 9 – with yarn b,  
ch 1, dc into each st  
around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st,  
fo B

Row 10 – rept row 9  
with yarn C  
Fasten off and  
weave in all ends.

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
