$2 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ Balls of Pato Everyday DK in Coral 969
4.50 mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle
$3 \times 17 \mathrm{~mm}$ Buttons of your choice

## Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used
The numbers at the end of the rounds in brackets, are the amount of stitches you should have at the end of that row.

The CH 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.
The yoke section has 2 types of increases, which are colour coded. Please see the abbreviations section and follow the colour prompts in the pattern.

Gauge - On the Yoke: 12 Treble crochet and 8 rows $=4$ " [10 cm]

## Abbreviations -

| TC - Treble Crochet | SP - Space |

| HTC - Half Treble Crochet | NXT - Next |
| DC - Double Crochet | T - Turn your work |
| CH - Chain | REM - Remaining |
| SS - Slip Stitch | ST - stitch |
| REP - Repeat | SK - Skip |
| INC 1 - Increase style 1-2 x TC + CH 1 + $2 \times$ TC in Chain 1 space from the row before |  |
| INC 2 - Increase style $2-1 \times$ TC + CH $1+1 \times$ TC in Chain 1 space from the row before |  |

## Yoke Section

CH-57
Row 1- CH 1 / Starting in 2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ ST / TC 11 / CH 1 / TC 8 / CH 1 / TC 18 / CH 1 / TC 8 / CH 1 / TC 11 (56)
Row 2-CH 1 / T / TC 11 / INC / TC 8 / INC / TC 18 / INC / TC 8 / INC / TC 11
Row 3-CH 1 / T / TC 13 / INC / TC 12 / INC / TC 22 / INC / TC 12 / INC / TC 13
Row 4 - CH 1 / T / TC 14 / INC / TC 14 / INC / TC 24 / INC / TC 14 / INC / TC 14
Row 5-CH 1 / T / TC 16 / INC / TC 18 / INC / TC 28 / INC / TC 18 / INC / TC 16
Row 6-CH 1 / T / TC 17 / INC / TC 20 / INC / TC 30 / INC / TC 20 / INC / TC 17
Row 7-CH 1 / T / TC 19 / INC / TC 24 / INC / TC 34 / INC / TC 24 / INC / TC 19
Row 8 - CH 1 / T / TC 20 / INC / TC 26 / INC / TC 36 / INC / TC 26 / INC / TC 20
Row 9-CH 1 / T / TC 22 / INC / TC 30 / INC / TC 40 / INC / TC 30/ INC / TC 22

## Separating for Sleeves

Row 10-CH 1 / T / TC $23 / 2 \times$ TC in the CH 1 SP / SK $32 / 2 \times$ TC in the CH 1 SP / TC $42 / 2 \times$ TC in
the CH 1 SP / SK 32 / $2 \times$ TC in the CH 1 SP / TC 23

## Body Section

Row 11 - CH 1 / T / TC across
Row 12-CH 1 / T / TC 13 / ** 2 x TC / TC $13^{* *}$ rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to** 4 more times / 2 x TC / TC 12 (102)
Row $13-\mathrm{CH} 1 / \mathrm{T} / \mathrm{TC} 4 /{ }^{* *} \mathrm{SK} 1 / \mathrm{TC}+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{TC}+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{TC}+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{TC}$ in the NXT ST / SK $1 / \mathrm{TC} 4 / \mathrm{rep}$ from ** till end (15 sets of 4 TC and 14 pattern repeats)

Row $14-\mathrm{CH} 1 / \mathrm{T} / 1 \mathrm{TC}$ in the NXT $4 /{ }^{* *} \mathrm{CH} 2 /$ In the 2 nd CH 2 SP work $\mathrm{DC}+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{DC} / \mathrm{CH} 2 /$ In the 4 TC
from the row before, work 1 TC in each ST / Rep from ** till End
Row 15 / - CH $1 / \mathrm{T} /{ }^{* *} 1 \mathrm{TC}$ in the NXT 4 TC / In the CH 2 SP work TC $+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{TC}+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{TC}+\mathrm{CH} 2+\mathrm{TC} /$ REP from ${ }^{* *}$ till end

Repeat rows 14 and 15 another 10 times or until desired length, finishing on row 15
Fasten Off.

## Button Band

Left -
Row 1 - Attach yarn at top left edge / CH 1 and work DC all the way to the bottom
Rows 2-3 CH 1/T / DC evenly till the end of the row, you should have approximately 62 STS
Fasten Off

## Right -

Row 1 - Attach yarn to the bottom corner, CH 1 and work DC evenly all the way to the top (approx. 62 DC)
Row 2 - CH 1 / T / DC in NXT 2 / CH 2 / SK 2 / DC in the NXT 6 / CH 2 / SK 2 / DC in the NXT 6 / CH 2 / SK 2 / DC till the end

Row 3-CH 1/T / Work DC in every stitch, making sure to place $2 \times$ DC in every buttonhole.

Fasten off

Sew the buttons onto row 2 on the left side

Weave in all ends


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
