MARSHMALLOW PIES
SHAWL

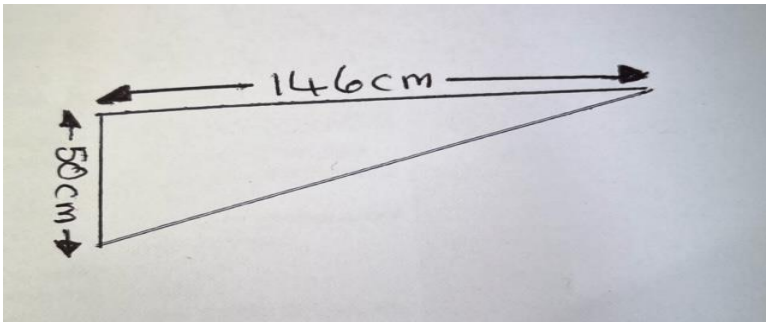
MATERIALS

Cygnets Marshmallow Pies 150g cake ball shade 1300 l'm Yacht Leaving

A pair of 4 mm (US 6) straight knitting needles

Stitch markers

DIMENSIONS (worked from tip to 50cm cast off edge)



TENSION is not important for this project

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) stitch(es) RS right side K knit p purl rept repeat sl slip sm slip marker pm place marker
inc increase tog together ssk slip one, k1, pass slipped stitch over

Kpk [k1, p1, k1] all into next st. 2 sts increased

Wrap 3 with yarn at back of work, insert RH needle between 3rd and 4th stitches on LH needle, drape a loop of yarn through between these sts from back to front and place on RH needle, K next 3 sts on LH needle.

Yo2 work 2 yarn over needles. Wrapping yarn twice round needle.

Kfb k into front and back of next st

SHAWL

The stitch pattern begins with a wrap stitch, then in the 2nd pattern section this is extended with a large double eyelet and concluded with the 3rd pattern section of garter stitch rows with a similar 4 row lace pattern.

Start Knitting

Cast on 1 st.

Row 1 (RS) kpk, k1. 3 sts

Row 2,4,6 and 8: sl 1, K to end.

Row 3: sl 1, kpk, k1. 5 sts

Row 5: sl 1, k1, kpk, k2. 7 sts

Row 7: sl 1, k1, kfb, kpk, k3. 10 sts

Row 9: sl 1, k1, kfb, pm k1, wrap3, k to end. 11 sts

Row 10: sl 1, K2, P2, p tog next st and loop, p1, sm, k to end.

Row 11: sl 1, k to end. Slipping marker

Row 12: sl 1, K2, p to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 13: sl 1, k1, kfb, k to marker, sm, k1, wrap3, k to end. 1 st inc'd.

Rows 14 to 21: Rep rows 10 – 13 twice. 14 sts.

Rows 22-24: Rep rows 10 – 12, removing marker on final row.

Pattern A

Row 1 (RS) sl 1, k1, kfb, pm, * k1, wrap3, rept from * to last 3 sts, k3. 15 sts

Row 2: sl 1, k2, * P2 ptog next st and loop, p1, rept from * to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 3: sl 1, k to end, slipping marker.

Row 4: Sl 1, k2, p to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 5: sl 1, k1, kfb, k to marker, sm, * K1, wrap 3, rept from * to last 3 sts, k3. 1 st inc'd. 16 sts

Rows 6 to 13: Rept rows 2 – 5 twice. 18 sts.

Rows 14 to 16: rept rows 2 – 4, removing marker on final row.

Rept these 16 rows a further 6 times. 42 sts.

Pattern B

Row 1: (RS) sl 1, k1, kfb, pm, * k1, wrap3, rept from * to last 3 sts, k3. 43 sts

Row 2: sl 1, k2, * p2, ptog next st and loop, p1, rept from * to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 3: sl 1, k to marker, sm, * k2tog, yo2, ssk, rept from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 4: sl 1, k2, * p1, [p1, k1] into yo2, p1, rept from * to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 5: sl 1, k1, kfb, k to marker, sm, * k1, wrap3, rept from * to last 3 sts, k3. 1 st inc'd

Rows 6 to 13: Rept rows 2 – 5 twice. 46 sts.

Rows 14 to 16: Rept rows 2 – 4, removing marker on final row.

Rept these 16 rows to 66 sts

Pattern C

Row 1: (RS) sl 1, k1, kfb, * k1, wrap3, rept from * to last 3 sts, k3. 67 sts

Row 2: sl 1, k2, * p2, ptog next st and loop, p1, rept from * to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 3: sl 1, k to marker, sm, * k2tog, yo2, ssk, rept from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 4: sl 1, k2, * p1, [p1, k1] into yo2, p1, rept from * to marker, sm, k to end.

Row 5: sl 1, k1, kfb, k to end, slipping marker. 1 st inc'd

Rows 6 – 8: sl 1, k to end, slipping marker.

Row 9: sl 1, k1, kfb, k to marker, sm, * k1, wrap3, rept from * to last 3 sts, k3. 1 st inc'd.

Row 10: sl 1, k2, * p2, ptog next st and loop, p1, rept from * to marker, sm, k to en.

Rows 11 to 12: rept rows 3-4.

Rows 13 to 16: rept rows 5 – 8, removing marker on final row. 70 sts

Rept these 16 rows to 94 sts, making sure that approx. 5g of yarn remains for working the picot edged border.

Picot Border

*Cast on 2 sts, cast off these 2 sts, turn, slip the st on the left hand needle back onto the right hand needle, cast off 4 sts, turn. Repeat from *. There will be a slight gap between that stitch and the next one on the left needle, which is totally normal. Repeat until you are out of stitches to cast off. Fasten off. Weave in the ends.



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
