LADIES SLEEVELESS VEST
SUGARSPUN

MEASUREMENTS

To fit Bust 102 and 112 cm, 40 and 44 in

MATERIALS

3(4) 100g balls Cygnet Sugar Spun shade Cotton Candy 3440

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Tension:

15 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, measured over rib pattern using 5 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

NOTES: Instructions are given for 102 cm, 40 in, larger size is given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to both sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

Knitting Needles:

1 pair of 5 mm (UK 6 -US9)

Abbreviations:

alt alternate	K knit	ssk slip, slip, knit 2 tog through back of both slipped sts
beg beginning	P purl	st(s) stitch(es)
cm centimetres	pm place marker	sm slip marker
cont continue	psso pass slipped st over	tog together
dec decrease(ing)	rem remaining	tbl through back of loops
fol following	rept repeat	ws wrong side
g grammes	rnd round	yf yarn forward
inc increase(ing)	rs right side	yo yarn over
in(s) inch(es)	skpo slip one, k1, pass slipped stitch over	

Special Abbreviations:

K1B

Insert needle through centre of st below next st on needle and knit this in the usual way, slipping the st above off needle at same time.

BACK AND FRONT (Both alike)

Cast on 67[73] sts and work 6 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Foundation Row: K1[P1, K1] 3 times, inc in next st, K to last 7 sts, K1[P1, K1] 3 times. 68[74] sts.

Commence Pattern

1st row: (ws) Rib 7, * K1B, K1, rept from * to last 9 sts, K2, rib to end. Rept last row twice more.

4th row: Rib 7, inc in next st, K1, * K1B, K1, rept from * to last 9 sts, K1B, inc in next st, rib 7. 70[76] sts

5th row: Rib 7, K1, * K1B, K1, rept from * to last 8 sts, K1, rib to end.

6th row: Rib 7, inc in next st, patt to last 9 sts, k1, inc in next st, rib 7. 72[78] sts

7th row: Rib 7, patt to last 10 sts, K1, rib 7, k2.

8th row: Rib 7, K1B, K1, patt to last 9 sts, K2, rib 7.

9th row: Rib 7, patt to last 8 sts, K1, rib 7.

10th row: Rib 7, inc in next st, K1, patt to last 9 sts, K1B, inc in next st, rib 7. 74[80] sts

11th row: Rib 7, K1, patt to last 8 sts, K1, rib 7.

12th row: Rib 7, K1, patt to last 8 sts, K1, rib 7.

13th row: Rib 7, K1, patt to last 8 sts, K1, rib 7.

14th row: Rib 7, inc in next st, patt to last 8 sts, inc in next st, rib 7. 76[82] sts

15th row: Rib 7, K2, patt to last 9 sts, K2, rib 7.

16th row: Rib 7, inc in next st, patt to last 8 sts, k1, rib 7. 77[83] sts.

Cont without further shaping until piece measures 33cm, 13 in ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 67[73] sts.

Cont in patt dec one st at each end of next and every foll alt row to 43[49] sts.

Work without further shaping until armholes measure 15[20] cm, 6[8] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Neck

Next row: Patt 13[16] turn and work on these sts only.

** Dec one st at neck edge in next 3 rows. 10[13] sts.

Work without further shaping until armhole measures 23[28] cm, ending with a ws row. Cast off.

With rs facing, slip centre 17 sts to a holder and patt to end.

Complete from ** on first side of neck.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, pick up and K17 sts evenly down side of front neck, K across 17 sts at centre front, pick up and K17 sts up side of neck, 17 sts down side of back neck, K across 17 sts across centre back and pick up and K16 sts up side of back neck. 101 sts.

Work 6 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib.

ARMBANDS

Join left shoulder seam. With rs facing, pick up and K57 sts evenly around armhole edge to shoulder and 56 sts evenly down other side to cast off sts at armhole. Work 6 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib.

FINISHING OFF

Join side seams. Sew in all ends.

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
