Peppermint Stick Chunky C2C Cowl

Measurements

Finished cowl measures 70cm x 25 cm

Materials

Folly Garden Peppermint 20303

10mm crochet hook

Abbreviations

ch	Chain	tr	treble stitch	ss	slip stitch	st	Stitch
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Notes

This pattern uses the 'corner to corner' crochet technique. As the name suggests you are working from one corner of the cowl to the opposite corner by crocheting an increasing and then decreasing number of blocks.

I have given written instructions for the first 3 rows and information on how to decrease rows.

Decrease Rows:

As you are making an elongated rectangle you will need to alternate increases and decreases at the end of row 7.

You will decrease on one side (to maintain the width) and increase on the other side (to create the length)

At the beginning of a decrease row do not ch 6, instead you need to turn your work and work 3 ss along the edge of the block you just made. Once you have slip stitched into the ch 3 space you can ch 3 and start building blocks as per the increase rows.

Pattern

Row 1: ch 6, tr in 4th ch from hook, tr in remaining 2 ch (1st block made).

Row 2: ch 6, tr in 4th ch from hook, tr in remaining 2 ch (2nd block made), turn the 1st block and ss into the space between the turning chain and 1st tr of the first block, ch 3, 3tr into same space to create 3rd block and complete this row.

Row 3: ch 6, tr in the 4th ch from hook, tr in remaining 2 ch, turn work and ss into space between ch 3 and 1st tr of previous block,

ch 3, 3tr in same space, ss to next block, ch 3, 3tr in same space to complete the row.

Row 4 - 7: Continue increasing in the same way as described in row 3.

Row 8 - 19: Work a decrease row on even rows and an increase row (as worked row 4-7) on odd rows

Row 20 - 25: Work decrease rows until you complete the cowl, do not fasten off after the last square.

Finishing Touches

With the top and bottom edges held together, slip stitch across the edge to join the ends and create a continuous piece.

Fasten off and sew in ends.

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
