A Day at the Beach Blanket
SILCARESS DK

Measurements

Size: approx. 60 x 90cm (23.5"x35.5")

Materials

Yarn - Cygnet Silcaress DK Range

White (2080) - 100g x3

Cornflower (2119) – 100g x1

Lagoon Breeze (2107) - 100g x1

Apple (2956) - 100g x1

Buttercup (2887) - 100g x1

Spring Peach (2148) - 100g x1

Fondant (2837) - 100 x1

Hook - 4.5mm

Scissors

Stitch Marker

Tapestry/Wool Needle

Tension

19 stitches x 13 rows (4 inch square)

Abbreviations

CH - Chain

SS – Slip stitch

DC - Double crochet

HTR - Half treble crochet

TR – Treble crochet

STS – Number of stiches

FLO – Front loop only

PM - Place marker

RS – Right side facing

WS – Wrong side facing

Notes

- Patterns written in UK Terms.
- Ch1 at the beginning of each row DOES NOT count as a stitch.
- Ch2 DOES count as a stitch unless otherwise stated.

- Block stitch rows (coloured dc rows) are always RS facing.
- Block stitch rows, keep White attached with a PM.

Pattern

To Start – 4.5mm hook, In **White** chain 119, now start in the 5th chain from the hook (3ch will count as a stitch).


Row 1 - RS

Tr in each chain along, pm in the last stitch [116 sts].

Note – Don't break white yarn, you will pick this up in the next block stitch row.

Row 2 - RS Join Cornflower between ch3 and first tr made (see pic 1 below).

Ch1, dc, *ch2, skip 3, dc in space between next 2 tr's (see pic 2 below) * repeat ** to the end, tie off and break yarn [39dc's, 38 ch2 spaces].



Row 3 – WS Pick up White yarn from pm, turn.

Ch2, *3tr over ch2 from previous row* repeat ** to the end, tr in last stitch, pm, turn [116 sts].

Row 4 - RS Join Lagoon Breeze

Repeat row 2.

Row 5 – RS Pick up White yarn from pm, turn.

Ch2, *3tr over ch2 from previous row* repeat ** to the end, tr in last stitch, pm [116 sts].

Row 6 – RS Join Apple

Repeat row 2.

Row 7 - WS

Repeat row 3.

Row 8 - RS Join Buttercup

Repeat row 2.

Row 9 - RS

Repeat row 5.

Row 10 - RS Join Spring Peach

Repeat row 2.

Row 11 - WS

Repeat row 3.

Row 12 - RS Join Fondant

Repeat row 2.

Row 13 - RS

Repeat row 5. Don't Break yarn, turn.

Row 14 - WS

Ch1, dc in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 15 - RS Join Fondant

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 16 - WS Join Spring Peach

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 17 - RS Join Buttercup

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 18 - WS Join Apple

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 19 – RS Join Lagoon Breeze

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 20 - WS Join Cornflower

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 21 - RS Join White

Ch1, dc in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 22 - WS

Tr in each stitch, pm in the last stitch [116 sts].

Row 23 - RS Join Cornflower

Repeat row 2.

Row 24 - RS

Repeat row 5.

Row 25 - RS Join Lagoon Breeze

Repeat row 2.

Row 26 - WS

Repeat row 3.

Row 27 - RS Join Apple

Repeat row 2.

Row 28 - RS

Repeat row 5.

Row 29 - RS Join Buttercup

Repeat row 2.

Row 30 - WS

Repeat row 3.

Row 31 - RS Join Spring Peach

Repeat row 2.





Row 32 - RS

Repeat row 5.

Row 33 - RS Join Fondant

Repeat row 2.

Row 34 - WS

Repeat row 3.

Row 35 - RS

Ch1, dc in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 36 - WS Join Fondant

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 37 - RS Join Spring Peach

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 38 – WS Join Buttercup

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 39 - RS Join Apple

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 40 – WS Join Lagoon Breeze

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 41 - RS Join Cornflower

Ch1, htr in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 42 - WS Join White

Ch1, dc in each stitch, turn [116 sts].

Row 43 - RS

Tr in each stitch, pm in the last stitch [116 sts].

Rows 44 - 85

Repeat rows 2 - 43.

Rows 86 - 118

Repeat rows 2 - 34.

Don't Break yarn.





Border

To Start – Turn your blanket RS facing.

Round 1 - In White (still attached)

Ch1, *htr evenly across the top of your blanket, in the last stitch (2htr, ch2, 2htr) this will be your first corner, now htr evenly down the edge of your blanket, I did the following stitches into the edge of the blanket:

2htr – tr rows

1htr – dc rows

1htr/2htr alternated – htr rows, please see the pics below of my border into the row edges. (2htr, ch2, 2htr) in last stitch, this will be your second corner* repeat ** completing your 3rd and 4th corners, ss to the first htr.





Round 2 – Attach Cornflower to any ch2 space.

Flo, ss in each stitch across, (dc, ch2, dc) in the ch2 space, flo, ss in each stitch to the next corner, (dc, ch2, dc) repeat around your blanket to the end, ss to the first ss.

Round 3 – Attach **White** to any ch2 space.

Dc in the white loop behind the ss from round 2 (see picture below) in each stitch across, (dc, ch2, dc) in the ch2 space, dc in each stitch to the next corner, (dc, ch2, dc) in the next ch2 space, repeat around your blanket to the end, ss to the first dc.





Round 4 – Attach **Fondant** to any ch2 space.

Repeat round 2.

Round 5 – Attach **White** to any ch2 space.

Ch1, htr in the white loop behind the ss from round 4 in each stitch across, (3htr) in the ch2 space, htr in each stitch to the next corner, (3htr) in the next ch2 space, repeat around your blanket to the end, ss to the first htr. (Pic of finished border above).

Break yarn, sew all ends in.
