SCRUMPALICIOUS Hooded cowl and mitts

## Materials

Cygnet Scrumpalicious $2 \times 200 \mathrm{~g}$ balls Powder Pink 3003 and an oddment of any Black chunky or Aran weight yarn
$4.5 \mathrm{~mm}, 8.00 \mathrm{~mm}$ and 10.00 mm crochet hooks

## Hood Measurements

Toddler Size= $10^{\prime \prime}$ wide, $15^{\prime \prime}$ high
Child Size= $11^{\prime \prime}$ wide, $16.25^{\prime \prime}$ high
Ladies Size= $12^{\prime \prime}$ wide, $18^{\prime \prime}$ high

## Hood Tension

7 dc and 4 rows to 10 cm (4in) on 10 mm hook

## Abbreviations

ch= Chain
$\mathrm{dc}=$ Double Crochet
$s l=s t i p$ stitch
fpdc= front post double crochet
bpdc= back post double crochet
$s c=$ single croche $\dagger$

## Special Stitches

Increase: single crochet 2 into one stitch
Notes:

- This is an easy/beginner level crochet pattern
- Pattern written in US crochet terms
- When you see a number directly in front of the stitch "2sc" - work 2 single crochet sts into the same stitch.
- When a number is written after the stitch "sc 2" - work 1 single crochet into each of the next 2 sts.


## Pattern for the Hood Body

Using 10.00mm hook, chain $22(25,28)$
Row 1: Starting in 3rd ch from hook, dc $19(22,25)$, dc 3 in last ch, turning in "u" shape as you go, dc $19(22,25)$ and turn. $(41,47,53)$

Row 2: ch 2, dc $20(23,26)$, dc 3 in next st, dc $20(23,26)$ and turn $(43,49,55)$
Row 3: ch 2, dc $21(24,27)$, dc 3 in next st, dc $21(24,27)$ and turn $(45,51,57)$
Row 4: ch 2, dc $22(25,28)$, dc 3 in next ch, dc $22(25,28)$ and turn $(47,53,59)$
Row 5: ch 2, dc $23(26,29)$, dc 3 in next ch, dc $23(26,29)$ and turn $(49,55,61)$
Row 6: ch 2, dc $24(27,30)$, dc 3 in next ch, dc $24(27,30)$ and turn $(51,57,63)$
Row 7-10: ch 2, dc $51(57,63)$ across and turn. $(51,57,63)$
** For the Toddler size, you will fasten off after row 10, leaving a long tail for whip stitching the cowl

Row 11: ch 2, dc $57(63)$ across and turn $(57,63)$
** For the Child size, you will fasten off after row 11, leaving a long tail for whip stitching the cowl

Row 12: ch 2, dc 63 across and fasten off leaving long tail for whip stitching the cowl.
Mark 10th chain from bottom on both openings of the hood (for all 3 sizes). Whip stitch upwards to join together the first 10 stitches, fasten off and weave in end.

## Finishing Touches to the Hood

Round 1: Working in the opening for your face (forming the hood), chain 2, *fpdc, bpdc* repeat from * around, sl st into first fpdc. $(33,39,45)$
**You will be working into the posts of the cowl section at the very base of the hood. These may be a little difficult to locate, but the additional 2 post stitches will help make sure the hood is wide enough to fit over most heads.

Round 2: ch 2, *fpdc into the fpdc from previous round, bpdc into the bpdc from previous round* repeat from * around, fasten off. $(33,39,45)$

## Pattern for the Ears

Using 4.5 mm crochet hook and Black yarn
Row 1: chain 4 turn and sc 2 into 2 nd ch from hook, sc 2 in each across, turn (6)

Row 2: ch 1, *sc, increase*, repeat from * across, turn (9)
Row 3: ch 1, *sc 2, increase*, repeat from * across, turn (12)
Row 4: ch 1, * sc 3, increase*, repeat from * across, turn (15)
Row 5: ch 1, *sc 4, increase*, repeat from * across, turn (18)
**For Toddler size, fasten off here (at the end of row 5)
Row 6: ch 1, *sc 5, increase*, repeat from * across, turn (21)
** For Child size, fasten off here (at the end of row 6)
Row 7: ch 1, *sc 6, increase*, repeat from * across, fasten off (24)

HEART APPLIQUE (Make 4 in Black yarn) 2 Ears - 2 Paws
Crochet Heart Pattern:

## Round 1:

Make a magic ring and ch 3

- $\quad \operatorname{Tr} 2$
- Dc 3
- $\quad \operatorname{Tr} 1$
- $D \subset 3$
- $\quad \operatorname{Tr} 2$

Ch 3

- Pull the magic ring to close it off and finish the round with a sl st through the centre.

Attach the Hearts to Cowl Hood and Mittens

## MITTENS

Tension 8 sts and 5 rows equal to 4 in using 8 mm crochet hook in dc

## Abbreviations

BLO - Back Loop Only, CH - Chain, DC - Double Crochet, DC2TOG - Double Crochet Decrease, FLO - Front Loop Only, HDC - Half Double Crochet, REP - Repeat, SC - Single Crochet, SK(D) Skip(ped), SL - Slip, SP - Space, ST(S) - Stitch(es)

## Toddler: Make 2

## Cuff

Row 1: Ch 5, work 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across, turn-4 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1 (not included as a st, here and throughout), work 1 sc in the blo of each st across, turn-4 sts.

Rows 3-10: Rep row 2, after last row ch 1

To join the cuff, fold the cuff in half with RS facing. SI st the last row to row 1, working through the blo of each st across. Flip the cuff so that the seam is on thRows 3-10: Rep row 2, after last row ch 1

## Body

Setup round: Ch 1, evenly work 10 sc sts around the band ( $1 \mathrm{st} / \mathrm{row}$ ), sl st in the first sc to join10 sts.

Round 1: Ch 2 (not incl. as a st here and throughout), *1 dc in first 2 sts, 2 dc in next; rep from * around, 2 dc in last st, sl st in the first dc to join-14 sts.

## Separate Thumb and Upper hand

Round 2: Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 sts, sk 4 sts (leaving an opening for thumb), dc next 5 sts, sl st in the first dc to join-10 sts.

## Continue working the upper hand of the mitten, leaving the thumb unworked.

Round 3: Ch 2, dc in each st around, sl st in the first dc to join-10 sts.

Round 4: Ch 2, *dc2tog across first 2 sts; rep from * around, sl st in the first dc to join—5 sts. Fasten off with a tail for weaving.

With tapestry needle weave through the flo of each st around, pull tight closing the top of the mittens. Weave in all ends.

## Thumb

Join yarn into the first skd st of round 2.

Round 1: Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 sts, sl st in the first dc to join-4 sts. Fasten off with a long tail for weaving. With tapestry needle weave through the flo of each st around, pull tight closing the top of the thumb. Use the tail to sew the side thumb opening closed. Weave ends.

Make an optional twisted cord using any leftover Scrumpalicious.

## Child: Make 2

Cuff
Row 1: Ch 6, work 1 sc in the 2 nd ch from the hook and in each ch across, turn- 5 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1 (not included as a st, here and throughout), work 1 sc in the blo of each st across, turn-5 sts.

Rows 3-12: Rep row 2, after last row ch 1

To join the cuff, fold the cuff in half with RS facing. Sl st the last row to row 1, working through the blo of each st across. Flip the cuff so that the seam is on the inside.

## Body

Setup round: Ch 1, evenly work 12 sc sts around the band ( $1 \mathrm{st} / \mathrm{row}$ ), sl st in the first sc to join12 sts.

Round 1: Ch 2 (not incl. as a st here and throughout), *1 dc in first 2 sts, 2 dc in next; rep from * around, sl st in the first dc to join-16 sts.

Round 2: Ch 2, *1 dc in first 4 sts, 2 dc in next; rep from * around, dc in last st, sl st in the first dc to join-19 sts.

## Separate Thumb and Upper hand

Round 3: Ch 2, dc in each of next 7 sts, sk 5 sts (leaving an opening for thumb), dc next 7 sts, sl st in the first dc to join-14 sts.

## Continue working the upper hand of the mitten, leaving the thumb unworked.

Rounds 4-5: Ch 2, dc in each st around, sl st in the first dc to join-14 sts.

Round 6: Ch 2, *dc2tog across first 2 sts; rep from * around, sl st in the first dc to join—7 sts. Fasten off with a tail for weaving.

With tapestry needle weave through the flo of each st around, pull tight closing the top of the mittens. Weave in all ends.

## Thumb

Join yarn into the first skd st of round 3 .

Round 1: Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 sts, sl st in the first dc to join- 5 sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, sl st in the first hdc to join- 5 sts. Fasten off with a long tail for weaving. With tapestry needle weave through the flo of each st around, pull tight closing the top of the thumb. Use the tail to sew the side thumb opening closed. Weave ends.

Make an optional twisted cord using any leftover Scrumpalicious

## Ladies: Make 2

## Cuff

Row 1: Ch 7, work 1 sc in the 2 nd ch from the hook and in each ch across, turn- 6 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1 (not included as a st, here and throughout), work 1 sc in the blo of each st across, turn-6 sts.

Rows 3-14: Rep row 2, after last row ch 1

To join the cuff, fold the cuff in half with RS facing. Sl st the last row to row 1, working through the blo of each st across. Flip the cuff so that the seam is on the inside.

## Body

Setup round: Ch 1, evenly work 14 sc sts around the band ( $1 \mathrm{st} / \mathrm{row}$ ), sl st in the first sc to join14 sts.

Round 1: Ch 2 (not incl. as a st here and throughout), * 1 dc in first 2 sts, 2 dc in next; rep from * around, dc in last 2 sts, sl st in the first dc to join-18 sts.

Round 2: Ch 2, *1 dc in first 3 sts, 2 dc in next; rep from * around, dc in last 2 sts, sl st in the first dc to join-22 sts.

## Separate Thumb and Upper hand

Round 3: Ch 2, dc in each of next 8 sts, sk 6 sts (leaving an opening for thumb), dc next 8 sts, sl st in the first dc to join-16 sts.

## Continue working the upper hand of the mitten, leaving the thumb unworked.

Rounds 4-6: Ch 2, dc in each st around, sl st in the first dc to join-16 sts.

Round 7: Ch 2, *dc2tog across first 2 sts; rep from * around, sl st in the first dc to join—8 sts. Fasten off with a tail for weaving.

With tapestry needle weave through the flo of each st around, pull tight closing the top of the mittens. Weave in all ends.

## Thumb

## Join yarn into the first skd st of round 3 .

Round 1: Ch 2, dc in each of next 6 sts , sl st in the first dc to join-6 sts.

Round 2: Ch 2, dc in each st around, sl st in the first dc to join-6 sts. Fasten off with a long tail for weaving. With tapestry needle weave through the flo of each st around, pull tight closing the top of the thumb. Use the tail to sew the side thumb opening closed. Weave ends.

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
