



## CY1673 ROBOT PATO CHUNKY

### Measurements and Materials

2 x 100g balls Cygnet Pato Chunky in shade 874 Dark Grey. Oddments of Red, Yellow, Black and Green Chunky

5.5mm (US 9) Knitting Needles

Stuffing

2 large and 2 small buttons for eyes

## ABBREVIATIONS

K Knit      P Purl      st(s) stitch(es)      tog together      tbl through back of loops      rs right side  
ws wrong side      kfb k into back and front of next st      alt alternate  
stst stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P)      rept repeat

## BODY

Using Grey cast on 9 sts.

**1<sup>st</sup> row (rs) [Kfb] 8 times, k1. 17 sts**

**2<sup>nd</sup> and every alt row Knit**

**3<sup>rd</sup> row [Kfb, k1] 8 times, k1. 25 sts**

**5<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k2] 8 times, k1. 33 sts**

**7<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k3] 8 times, k1. 41 sts**

**9<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k4] 8 times, k1. 49 sts**

**11<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k5] 8 times, k1. 57 sts**

**13<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k6] 8 times, k1. 65 sts**

**15<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k7] 8 times, k1. 73 sts**

**17<sup>th</sup> row [Kfb, k8] 8 times, k1. 81 sts.**

**18<sup>th</sup> row Knit**

Commencing with a K row work in stst for 16.5cm from garter stitch base end on a P row.

## Shape Top

**1<sup>st</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k8] 8 times, k1. 73 sts**

**2<sup>nd</sup> and every alt row Knit**

**3<sup>rd</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k7] 8 times, k1. 65 sts**

**5<sup>th</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k6] 8 times, k1. 57 sts**

**7<sup>th</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k5] 8 times, k1. 49 sts**

**9<sup>th</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k4] 8 times, k1. 41 sts**

**11<sup>th</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k3] 8 times, k1. 33 sts**

**13<sup>th</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k2] 8 times, k1. 25 sts**

**15<sup>th</sup> row [K2tog tbl, k1] 8 times, k1. 17 sts**

**17<sup>th</sup> row [k2tog tbl, k1] 8 times, k1. 9 sts**

**18<sup>th</sup> row Knit.** Cast off. Leave a long end to join seam.

Fold work flat, join back seam, stuff firmly. Sew top seam.

## ARMS (Both alike)

Using Grey cast on 10 sts.

**\*\*Work 4 rows in stst commencing with a P row.**

Using Red K1 row, then P 1 row.

Using Grey K2 rows. **\*\***

Rept from **\*\*** to **\*\*** twice more. Break off Red.

Using Grey work 6 rows in stst. Cast off. Sew both arms securely to each side of Body.

## **LEGS (Both alike)**

Using Grey cast on 10 sts.

Work 10 rows in stst and 10 rows in reversed stst. Repeat these 20 rows once more Cast off.

## **FEET (Both alike)**

Using Grey cast on 14 sts and commencing with a P row work 10 rows in stst.

Knit 2 rows then work a further 10 rows in stst. Rept last 12 rows once more.

Cast on 10 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 34 sts.

Work a further 10 rows in stst.

Cast off 10 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 14 sts. Cast off. Sew to make cubed boxes, stuff and close seam.

Join leg seams into a tube, stuff firmly as you go along then attach to body and feet

## **ANTANNAE**

**Base** Using Red cast on 12 sts and work 6 rows in stst. Cast off. Roll into a tube lengthwise and stitch tightly.

Using Red cast on 3 sts. Working in stst, inc one st at each end of every row to 11 sts. Dec one st at each end of every row to 3 sts. P3tog, fasten off. Sew up, stuff and close seam. Attach to base.

Using Green cast on 8 sts and work 4 rows in stst. Cast off. Roll into a tube lengthwise and stitch tightly.

Make another one and sew both to each side of base. Attach 2 small buttons. Attach to top centre of Body.

## **EAR DOMES (Make 2)**

Using Yellow cast on 30 sts. Kfb into each st. Cast off. Join into a spiral circle and attach to sides of Body.

## **EYE PANEL**

Using Black cast on 6 sts and work in stst until piece measures 12 cm. Cast off.

Sew in place onto front of Body. Use photo as a guide. Add larger buttons for eyes. Using Green, embroider detail between the eyes.

## **MOUTH PANEL**

Using Black cast on 6 sts and work in garter st (every row K) in the following sequence:

6 rows Black, 6 rows Green, 2 rows black, 6 rows Yellow, 2 rows Black, 6 rows Red, 6 rows Black. Cast off.

Sew in place.

Using Black, work a running stitch in a square all around face, this forms outline for face panel.

Using any contrast yarn, sew through the top stitches only of the black in a zig zag pattern.
