Materials

Cygnet Pato Chunky $2 \times 100g$ balls each of A) Black 886, B) White 888, C) Dark Grey 874, D) Light Grey 881 and $1 \times 100g$ ball of E) Sorbet 880

A pair of 6 ½ mm (UK 3) and 7 mm (UK 2) Knitting needles

Tension

14 sts and 19 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over stocking stitch on 7 mm (UK 2) Knitting needles

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS

IF TOO SMALL USE A LARGER NEEDLE, IF TOO LARGE USE A SMALLER NEEDLE

Abbreviations

K Knit	cm centimetres	stst stocking stitch

P Purl in inches (1 row K, 1 row P)

st(s) stitch(es) beg beginning rem remaining

inc increase foll following cont continue

dec decrease rs right side

BACK

Using 6 ½ mm needles and C cast on 62(70,78,86,90) sts and work 9[9,10,10,10] cm in K2, P2 rib, inc one st at each end of last row for 1st and 2nd sizes only.

All Sizes

64(72,78,86,90) sts. Break off C.

Change to 7 mm needles.

Commence Stripe Pattern

Work 16[16,16,20,20] rows in stst using D then the same again in E, C, D then B. Use photo for guidance

Shape Shoulders

Using B, cast off 21,25,27,31,33) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Leave rem 22(22,24,24,24) sts on a holder.

FRONT

Work exactly as given for Back until work measures 10 cm less than Back to Shoulders ending with a P row.

Shape Neck

Next row: Using B

K25(29,32,36,38) sts,turn and work on these sts only.

Work 4(4,5,5,5) rows dec one st at neck edge in every row.

21[25,27,31,33] sts

Cont straight until Front measures same as Back to Shoulders ending with a P row.

Cast off rem sts.

With rs facing, slip centre 14 sts to a holder and using B, K to end.

Work 4(4,5,5,5) rows dec one st

at neck edge in every row.

21[25,27,31,33] sts

Cont straight until Front measures same as Back to Shoulders ending with a K row.

Cast off rem sts.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 6 ½ mm needles and A cast on 34(38,38,42,42) sts and work 10 cm in K2, P2 rib, end with a rs row.

Next row: Rib to end, inc in every st. 68[76,76,84,84] sts.

Break off A.

Change to 7 mm needles.

Commence Stripe Pattern

Work 12[12,14,14,14] rows in stst using B then the same in A and B

again alternately until Sleeve measures

43[43, 46,46 48] cm or length required. Cast off loosely

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With rs facing and using 6 ½ mm

needles and B, pick up and K13 sts evenly down left side of front neck, K across 14 sts from centre front, pick up and K13 sts evenly up right side of front neck and K across 22(22,24,24,24)sts from holder at back of neck. 62(62,64,64,64) sts.

Work 6 rows in K2, P2 rib.

Cast off in rib.

FINISHING OFF

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. Fold sleeves in half lengthways then placing fold to shoulder seam, sew sleeves in position. Join side and sleeve seams matching stripes.
