**Cygnets Kiddies Supersoft Chunky  
Humpty Dumpty**

## Materials

1 x 100g Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Chunky Cream 2454 (MC)  
1 x 100g Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Chunky Violet 2871 (CC1)  
1 x 100g Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Chunky Clover 2062 (CC2)  
1 x 100g Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Chunky Biscuit 2936 (CC3)  
1 x 100g Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Chunky White 2080 (CC4)  
1 x 100g Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Chunky Petal 2385 (CC5)

6mm Crochet Hook

Safety Toy stuffing  
Stitch Marker  
Tapestry Needle  
1 pair of safety toy eyes

## Tension

Tension is not important as long as you maintain the same tension throughout.

## Sizing

Approx. 24cm height from bottom to top of head.

## Abbreviations

### This pattern is written in UK Crochet terms

Rnd Round

Ch Chain

St Stitch

Dc Double Crochet

Dc2tog Work 2 dc stitches together; Insert hook in to next st, yo, pull yarn through, then insert hook into next stitch, yo, pull through, yo, pull through three loops on hook.

Slst Slip Stitch

**Place a stitch marker at the beginning of each row so you don't lose your place.**

### Body

With 6mm hook and CC1.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: \*dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: \*dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 6: \*dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 7: \*dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 8: \*dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 9: \*dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnd 10: \*dc into next eight sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnd 11: \*dc into next nine sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (66sts)

Rnds 12: \*dc into next ten sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (72sts)

Rnd 13: \*dc into next eleven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (78sts)

Rnds 14-15: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 16: \*dc into next twelve sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (84sts)

Rnds 17-18: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 19: \*dc into next thirteen sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (90sts)

Rnds 20-23: Dc in to each st.

Change to CC2

Rnds 24-33: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 34: \*dc into next thirteen sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (84sts)

Change to MC

Rnds 35-38: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 39: \*dc into next twelve sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (78sts)

Rnds 40-42: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 43: \*dc into next eleven sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (72sts)

Rnds 44-45: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 46: \*dc into next ten sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (66sts)

Rnd 47: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 48: \*dc into next nine sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnd 49: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 50: \*dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnd 51: \*dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 52: \*dc into next six sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (42sts)

Fix eyes between rows 45 and 46 approximately 4cm apart.

Stuff and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnd 53: \*dc into next five sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 54: \*dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 55: \*dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 56: \*dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 57: \*dc into next one sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (12sts)

Rnd 58: \*dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (6sts)

Thread yarn through these 6 sts and pull tight to close the opening.

### **Nose**

With 6mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnds 3-4: Dc in to each st.

Stuff the nose.

Rnd 5: \*dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (6sts)

Fasten off.

### **Cheeks**

Make 2.

With 6mm hook and CC5.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Fasten off.

### **Bandage**

Make 2.

With 6mm hook and CC4 chain 13.

Row 1: starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 12 dc. (12 sts)

Fasten off.

### **Bow Tie**

With 6mm hook and CC1 chain 7.

Row 1: starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 6 dc. Turn. (6sts)

Row 2: 1 ch, 1 dc2tog, 2 dc, 1 dc2tog. Turn. (4 sts)

Row 3: 1 ch, 2 dc2tog. Turn. (2sts)

Rows 4-6: 1 ch, 2dc. Turn.

Row 7: 1 ch, 2 dc in to next two stitches. Turn. (4 sts)

Row 8: 1 ch, 2 dc into next stitch, 2 dc, 2 dc into next stitch. Turn. (6sts)

Row 9: 1 ch, 6 dc.

Fasten off.

### **Bowtie Center**

With 6mm hook and CC1.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Fasten off.

### **Arms**

Make 2.

With 6mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnds 3-5: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 6: \*dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (6sts)

Rnds 7: Dc in to each st.

Change to CC2.

Rnds 8-10: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 11: 2dc into next stitch, 2 dc, 2dc into next stitch, 2 dc. (8sts)

Rnds 12-14: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 15: 2dc into next stitch, 3 dc, 2dc into next stitch, 3 dc. (10sts)

Rnds 16-18: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 19: 2dc into next stitch, 4 dc, 2dc into next stitch, 4 dc. (12sts)

Rnds 20-22: Dc in to each st.

Now working across the next 6 sts only.

Row 23: Dc in to next six sts. Turn.

Row 24: 1 ch, 1 dc2tog, 2 dc, 1 dc2tog. Turn. (4sts)

Row 24: Dc in to next four sts. Turn.

Row 25: 1 ch, 1 dc2tog twice. (2sts)

Fasten off.

Leaving the hand unstuffed, stuff the upper part of the arm.

### **Thumbs**

Make 2.

With 6mm hook and MC chain 3.

Row 1: starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 2 dc. (2sts)

Fasten off.

Fold in half and join the starting and ending rows together.

### **Legs (including shoes)**

Make 2.

With 6mm hook and CC3.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 4: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnds 5-8: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 9: \*dc into next one sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (12sts)

Stuff foot.

Rnd 10: \*dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (9sts)

Rnds 11-12: Dc in to each st.

Change to CC1.

Rnd 13: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 14: \*dc in to next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (12sts)

Rnds 15-16: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 17: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnds 18-24: Dc in to each st.

Fasten off.

Stuff leg.

Bend foot up and fix row 8 of the foot to row 13 of the leg with a stitch so the foot stays in the upright position.

Using CC4 stitch two crosses on each shoe for laces.

### **Making Up**

Attach the nose just below the eyes.

Using a strand of CC3 stitch on a mouth.

Attach the cheeks to either side of the face.

Please refer to the photos for support on the positioning of all the facial features.

Attach the bow tie to the top of the middle section with the centre of the bow tie on the top.

Attach the bandage to the top right side of the head crossing the 2 pieces over each over to form a cross.

Attach the arms to either side of the body, bending the right arm up and fixing in position if you.

Humpty dumpty is designed to be sitting, so when attaching the legs it is best to have Humpty Dumpty on a table, position the legs either side and attach.
