Boho Spirit Twisted Wrap

Measurements and Materials

Circumference approx 112 cm

Boho Spirit 100g Unicorn 6778 2 balls

5 mm circular needle

Stitch Markers

ABBREVIATIONS

Sts stitches rnd round K knit tog together yfwd yarn forward skpo slip 1, K1, pass slipped st over
P purl patt pattern

Important Notes Due to the twist in the band of knitting, this shape has only one side and one edge ! With the twist, you may find it helpful to use stitch markers to indicate the end of each block of lace pattern repeats.

Usually when joining your work in the round it's most important to ensure your work isn't twisted but with this design that is exactly what you must do. Once you have cast on the correct amount of stitches, smooth them out so that the loops hang down, then turn half of them 180 degrees so the loops are at the top. By twisting the sts at the beginning the work will remain that way throughout creating the look of the twisting band.

Lace Ripple Stitch (multiples of 12 sts)

Rnd 1: K

Rnd 2: K

Rnd 3: K1, K2tog, K2tog, yfwd, (k1, yfwd) 3 times, [skpo] twice

Rnd 4: P

PATTERN

Cast on 144 sts. Turn row of sts to form a twist. Join in the rnd checking that the sts are twisted a full 360 degrees. This ensures that the right sides of the lace pattern appear on the outer section of the work and a twist is created in the centre.

Work in Lace Ripple patt until work measures 50 cm from cast on edge, finish on a Rnd 4.

Next row K all sts

Cast off knitwise



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
