



CY1755 Cygnet DK Festive Family Bobble Sweater

Measurements and Materials

To fit Chest 61 66 71 76 81 86 92 97 102 107 cm

24 26 28 30 32 34 36 38 40 42 in

2 balls

Cygnet DK 100g Fondant 173 A and Red 1206 D 1 1 1 1 1 2 2 2 2

Cygnet DK 100g Aqua 211 B and White 208 C one ball of both shades

A pair of 3.25mm (US 3) and 4 mm (US 6) knitting needles

Stitch holders

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over stocking stitch using 4 mm needles If your tension is too tight use a larger needle, if too loose use a smaller needle

ABBREVIATIONS

Stst stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P)

K knit P purl rept repeat sts stitch(es) inc increase dec decrease cont continue patt pattern

beg beginning tog together inc increase foll following

stst stocking stitch (1 row | K, 1 row P)

MB make a bobble by k1, p1, k1, p1, k1 all into next st, turn and P5, turn and K5, turn and P2tog, P1, P2tog, turn and K3tog

BACK AND FRONT ALIKE

Using 3.25 mm needles and B, cast on 79[85,91,97,103,109,115,121,127,133] sts.

Work 5[5,5,6,6,6,7,7,7,7] cm in K1, P1 rib, inc one st at end of last row.

80[86,92,98,104,110,116,122,128,134] sts. Break off B.

Change to 4 mm needles and cont in stst with A until work measures 26[30,34,36,39,41,42,42,42]cm from beg, ending with a P row.

Commence Fairisle Border

1st row K2B, * 4A, 2B, rept from * to end.

2nd row P2B, * 4A, 2B rept from * to end.

3rd row K3B,* 2A, 4B, rept from * to last 5 sts, 2A, 3B.

4th row P3B, * 2A, 4B, rept from * to last 5 sts, 2A, 3B. Break off A.

5th row with C K4 * MB, K3[5,5,4,5,5,5,5,5] rept from * to last 4 sts, MB, K3.

6th row with C Purl

7th row K3B,* 2D, 4B, rept from * to last 5 sts, 2D, 3B.

8th row P3B, * 2D, 4B, rept from * to last 5 sts, 2D, 3B.

9th row K2B, * 4D, 2B, rept from * to end.

10th row P2B, * 4D, 2B, rept from * to end. Break off B and continue with D.

Commence Pattern

1st row K3, * P2, K4, rept from * to last 5 sts, P2, K3.

2nd row Purl

3rd row P2, * K4, P2, rept from * to end.

4th row Purl

These 4 rows form the pattern.

Mark each end of work with a coloured thread. This denotes start of armhole.

Work a further 9[9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16,17] cm in patt from markers.

Shape Neck

Next row K31[34,37,37,40,40,43,43,46,49], turn and work on these sts only.

Next row Purl

** Dec one st at neck edge in every row until 19[22,35,25,28,28,31,31,34,37] sts remain.

Cont without further shaping until armholes measure 12.5[14,15,16.5,17.5,19,20.5,21.5,23,24] cm from markers ending with a P row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 10[11,13,13,14,14,16,16,17,19] sts at beg of next row.

Work one row then cast off remaining sts.

With right side facing, slip next 18[18,18,24,24,30,30,36,36,36] sts to a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end. Complete as given from ** on first side ending with a K row before shaping shoulder.

SLEEVES

Using 3.25 mm needles and B, cast on 39[41,41,43,45,47,49,49,51,51] sts.

Work 5[5,5,6,6,6,7,7,7,7] cm in K1, P1 rib, inc one st at end of last row. 40[42,42,44,46,48,50,50,52,52] sts. Break off B.

Change to 4 mm needles and cont in stst with A inc one st at each end of next and every foll 4th row to 62[68,74,80,86,92,98,104,110,116] sts.

Work without further shaping until Sleeve measures 21[24,28,32,34,34,37,39,39,42] cm from beg ending with a P row.

Commence Fairisle Border

Work the 10 rows as given for Body.

Commence Pattern

Work 4[4,6,6,8,8,10,10,12,12] rows in patt as given for Body. The sleeve length can be adjusted at this point to length required.

Work 2 rows in stst then cast off loosely.

NECKBAND

Using 3.25 mm needles and D, with right side facing pick up and K18[18,18,18,20,20,20,22,22,22] sts down side of neck, K across sts on holder at centre and pick up and K19[19,19,19,21,21,21,23,23,23] sts up other side of neck. 55[55,55,61,65,71,71,81,81,81]sts. Work 20 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off in rib. Work the other side the same way.

FINISHING OFF

Join shoulder and neckband seams. Fold sleeves in half lengthwise and placing centre of sleeve to shoulder, sew sleeves in place. Join side and sleeve seams.

The neckband can be folded in half to the inside and slip stitched loosely down to form a lovely snug crew neck.





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
