FOLLY GARDEN
LADIES CABLED SWEATER

MEASUREMENTS

Actual Bust measurement 43 in (107 cm)

MATERIALS

8 x 100g balls Cygnet Folly Garden shade 20505 Ice Plant

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

A pair of 8 mm (US 11) knitting needles

Cable needle

Stitch holders

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

TENSION

11 sts and 15 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) measured over cable pattern on Front using 8 mm needles.

IF YOUR TENSION IS TOO TIGHT USE A LARGER NEEDLE, IF TOO LARGE USE A SMALLER NEEDLE

ABBREVIATIONS

Sts stitch(es)

Rept repeat

Tog together

Stst stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P)

Cont continue

Cm centimetres

Ins inches

Ws wrong side

Dec decrease

Beg beginning

Rem remaining

Inc increase

Patt pattern

Tog together

Foll following

Rs right side

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C3R slip next 2 sts to a cable needle and hold at back of work, k1 then K2 from cable needle

C3L slip next st to a cable needle and hold at front of work, k2 then k1 from cable needle.

BACK

Cast on 54 sts and work 3 rows in K2, P2 rib.

4th row: Rib 2, rib 2tog, [rib 5, rib2tog] 7 times, rib 1. 46 sts

Proceed in stst until Back measures 41 cm ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Work 3 rows dec one st at each end of every row. 40 sts

Cont without further shaping until armholes measures 21 cm, ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Leave rem 16 sts on a holder.

FRONT

Cast on 54 sts and work 3 rows in K2, P2 rib.

4th row: Rib 9, inc in next st, [rib 8, inc in next st] 4 times, rib 8. 59 sts.

Commence Pattern

1st row: P6 * P2, K7, rept from * to last 8 sts, P8.

2nd row: K8, * P7, K2, rept from * to last 6 sts, K6.

3rd row: P6, * P2, C3R, K1, C3L, rept from * to last 8 sts, P8.

4th row: K8, * P7, K2, rept from * to last 6 sts, K6.

These 4 rows set rev stst and cable panels.

Keeping continuity of patt as set cont until Front measures 41 cm ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Work 3 rows dec one st at each end of every row. 53 sts

Cont without further shaping until armhole measures 14cm, ending with a ws row.

Shape Neck

Next row: Patt 17, turn and work on these sts only.

Work 3 rows dec one st at neck edge in every row. 14 sts

Cont without further shaping until armhole measures 20cm, ending with a rs row.

Next row: Patt3, patt2tog, patt2, patt2tog, patt 5. 12 sts.

Shape Shoulder

Next row: Cast off 6 sts in patt, patt to end.

Next row: Patt to end.

Cast off rem 6 sts.

With rs facing, slip first 19 sts onto a st holder, rejoin yarn to rem 17 sts and patt to end.

Work 3 rows dec one st at neck edge in every row. 14 sts

Cont without further shaping until armhole measures 20cm, ending with a ws row.

Next row: Patt5, patt2tog, patt2, patt2tog, patt 3. 12 sts.

Shape Shoulder

Next row: Cast off 6 sts in patt, patt to end.

Next row: Patt to end.

Cast off rem 6 sts.

SLEEVES

Cast on 26 sts and work 3 rows in K2, P2 rib.

4th row: Rib 4, rib 2tog, [rib 6, rib2tog] twice, rib 4. 23 sts

Cont in stst, inc one st at each end of 7th and every foll 10th row to 33 sts.

Cont without further shaping until sleeve measures 46cm, ending with a ws row.

Shape Top

Work 3 rows dec one st at each end of every row. 27 sts.

Work one more row.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 19 sts.

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 9 sts.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With rs facing, pick up and K9 sts evenly down left side of front neck, work across 19 sts at centre front as follows: k1, [k2tog] 9 times, pick up and K9 sts evenly up right side of front neck and work across 16 sts on holder at back neck as follows: k5, pick up loop between last and next st and work into back of this loop, this will now be referred to as M1, then K6, M1, K5. 46 sts. Work 3 rows in 2 x 2 rib.

Cast off in rib.

FINISHING OFF

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. Fold sleeves in half lengthways then placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in place. Join side and sleeve seams.

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
