## Materials

**Cygnet Pure Baby Prints**  
Shade Alice Blue 1816

### Hook

3.5mm hook

### Other

Black safety eyes or small amount of black and pink yarn or embroidery thread for face. Small pompom maker.

### Tension

Tension is not important, as long as you maintain the same tension throughout the project.

## Abbreviations

Note: to decrease, insert hook into next st, yo, pull yarn through, then insert hook into next st, yo, pull through, yo pull through three loops on hook.

**You may find it easier to place a stitch marker at the beginning of every row so you don't lose your place.**

### HEAD

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 sc in second ch from hook, join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc using slst to form a ring (6sts)  
Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around (12sts)  
Rnd 3: \*sc, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (18sts)  
Rnd 4: \*sc into next two sts, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (24sts)  
Rnd 5: \*sc into next three sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (30sts)  
Rnd 6: \*sc into next four sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (36sts)  
Rnd 7: \*sc into next five sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (42sts)

Rnd 8: \*sc into next six sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (48sts)

Rnds 9-20 sc in each st

**Note: if using black safety eyes, attach them now in Rnd 16 approximately 10sts apart.**

Rnd 21: \*sc in next six sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (42sts)

Rnd 22: \*sc in next five sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (36sts)

Rnd 23: \*sc in next four sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (30sts)

Rnd 24: \*sc in next three sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (24sts)

Rnd 25: \*sc in next two sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (18sts)

Stuff head firmly.

Rnd 26: \*sc in next st, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (12sts)

Rnd 27: dec six times (6sts)

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight and secure.

### BODY

Rnd 1: ch2, 6sc in second ch from hook, join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc using slst to form a ring (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around (12sts)

Rnd 3: \*sc, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (18sts)

Rnd 4: sc 18

Rnd 5: \*sc into next two sts, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (24sts)

Rnds 6-9: sc 24

Rnd 10: \*sc into next three sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (30sts)

Rnds 11-14: sc 30

Rnd 15: \*sc into next four sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (36sts)

Rnd 16: \*sc into next five sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (42sts)

Rnds 17-20: sc 42

Rnd 21: \*sc into next six sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (48sts)

Rnds 22-23 sc 48

Rnd 21: \*sc in next six sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (42sts)

Rnd 22: \*sc in next five sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (36sts)

Rnd 23: \*sc in next four sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (30sts)

Rnd 24: \*sc in next three sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (24sts)

Rnd 25: \*sc in next two sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (18sts)

Stuff body firmly.

Rnd 26: \*sc in next st, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (12sts)

Rnd 27: dec six times (6sts)

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight and secure.

### **ARMS (make two)**

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 sc in second ch from hook, join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc using slst to form a ring (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around (12sts)

Rnds 3-30: sc in each st

Rnd 31: \*sc, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (18sts)

Rnds 32-33: sc in each st

Stuff arm, but not too firmly.

Rnd 34: \*sc in next st, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (12sts)

Rnd 35: dec six times (6sts)

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight and secure.

### **LEGS (make two)**

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 sc in second ch from hook, join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc using slst to form a ring (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around (12sts)

Rnd 3: \*sc, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (18sts)

Rnds 4-27: sc in each st

Rnd 28: \*sc into next two sts, 2sc in next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (24sts)

Rnds 29-30: sc in each st

Rnd 31: \*sc into next three sts, 2sc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd (30sts)

Rnd 32: sc in each st

Rnd 33: \*sc in next three sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (24sts)

Rnd 34: \*sc in next two sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (18sts)

Stuff legs, but not too firmly.

Rnd 35: \*sc in next st, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (12sts)

Rnd 36: dec six times (6sts)

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight and secure.

### **EARS (make two)**

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 sc in second ch from hook, join to 1<sup>st</sup> sc using slst to form a ring (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2sc in each sc around (12sts)

Rnds 3-5: sc in each st

As working, press the ear into a flat oval with the start of the round at one of the corners

Rnd 6: \*sc into next five sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (14sts)

Rnds 7-9: sc into each st

Rnd 10: \*sc into next six sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (16sts)

Rnd 11: sc into each st

Rnd 12: \*sc into next seven sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (18sts)

Rnd 13: sc into each st

Rnd 14: \*sc into next eight sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (20sts)

Rnd 15: sc into each st

Rnd 16: \*sc into next nine sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (22sts)

Rnd 17: sc into each st

Rnd 18: \*sc into next ten sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (24sts)

Rnd 19: sc into each st

Rnd 20: \*sc into next eleven sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (26sts)

Rnd 21: sc into each st

Rnd 22: \*sc into next twelve sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (28sts)

Rnd 23: sc into each st

Rnd 24: \*sc into next thirteen sts, 2sc into next st; rep to end (30sts)

Rnds 25-28: sc into each st

Rnd 29: \*sc in next three sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (24sts)

Rnd 30: \*sc in next two sts, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (18sts)

Rnd 31: \*sc in next st, dec in next st; rep from \* to end (12sts)

Rnd 32: dec six times (6sts)

Thread yarn through remaining sts, pull tight and secure.

### **TAIL**

Use a small 3cm pompom maker to create a small pompom and trim until it is dense and neat. Alternatively, wrap yarn approximately 20 times around two fingers spaced slightly apart. Tie centre of yarn tightly and cut through all of the loops at each end. Fluff out into a pompom shape and trim to desired size.

## Making up

Attach body to head matching centre bottom of head with centre top of body. Stitch around on Rnd 3 or 4.

Attach arms at opposite sides of head.

Attach legs towards the front of the body to allow rabbit to sit. Position each leg 3-4 sts from centre front st and 5 rounds from bottom rnd of body and stitch in place around the top of the leg.

Attach ears to the top of the head on opposite sides, ensuring you line them up with the arms. Attach the ears from approximately the second round of the head.

Attach tail at centre back approximately 7 rnds from centre bottom so it holds rabbit in a sitting position.

Embroider eyes approximately two thirds down the head using black yarn or embroidery thread and back stitch. Embroider nose using pink yarn and satin stitch. Embroider mouth using black yarn and back stitch.
