CY1441 CYGNET PATO EVERYDAY DK CLUSTER CORNER HEXAGON BLANKET

Materials –

4 mm crochet hook

1 x 100g ball each of Pato everyday DK

Yarn A – Rose 942

Yarn B – Light Grey 978

Yarn C – White 999

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row.

Cluster – work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch or space

Corner – work a cluster + chain 2 + cluster into the chain 2 space of the row below

Abbreviations –

tr – treble crochet
htr – half treble
crochet

clus - clus
cor(s) – corner(s)
ch(s) - chain(s)
chsp- chain space

t - turn your work
nxt – next
rept - repeat
sk - skip

sp(s) - space(s)
slst – slip stitch
fo – fasten off

Blanket –

With yarn A ch 6, slst to join into a ring.

Row 1 – into ring, ch 1, [clus, ch 2] 6 times, slst to 1st tr

Row 2 – slst into ch 2 sp, into each ch 2 sp work a cor, slst to 1st tr, fo A

Row 3 – attach B into any ch 2 sp, * ch 1, cor into ch 2 sp, ch1, tr into sp bet cors, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr

Row 4 – slst into ch 2 sp, ch 1, * cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, tr into ch 1 sp, tr into tr, tr into ch 1 sp, ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr, fo B

Row 5 – attach C into any ch 2 sp, ch 1, * cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, tr into ch 1 sp, tr 3, tr into ch 1 sp, ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr

Row 6 – ch 1, * cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, tr into ch 1 sp, tr 5, tr into ch 1 sp, ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr, fo C

Row 7 – attach A into any ch 2 sp, ch 1, * cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, tr into ch 1 sp, tr 7, tr into ch 1 sp, ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr

Row 8 – slst into ch 2 sp, ch 1, * cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, tr into ch 1 sp, tr 9, tr into ch 1 sp, ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr, fo A

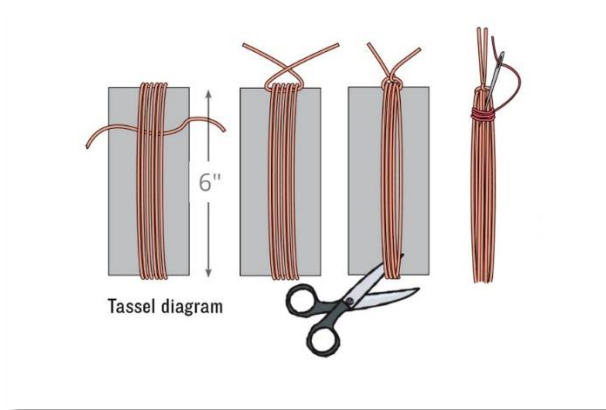
Continue to work as before changing colours every 2 rows, until you have worked 32 rows.

Trim -

Row 33 - attach yarn B into any ch 2 sp, ch 1, into ch 2 sp work 2 htr + ch 1 + 2 htr, htr into each tr, rept all the way around, slst to 1st htr.

Fasten off weave in all ends.

Tassels – make 6



To make tassels -

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6" in height
- Cut 2 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 20 times
- Slip one piece of yarn through the center and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths through the center to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top to attach
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down through the center to blend them in
- Trim Neatly

Attach tassels into the chain 1 space on all 6 corners, weave in all ends.



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
