Materials

Cygnet Sugarspun DK 100g 5:5:6:6 balls shade A 3880 Cotton Slub and one ball each of B 3110 Floating Island, C 3550 Whisper, D 3220 Cobweb and E 3440 Cotton Candy

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn

A pair of 4.5 mm hook (US 7)

TENSION

12 sts and 8 rows to 10 cm, 4 in measured over treble crochet on a 4.5 mm hook or size required to obtain stated tension

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS
If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker hook, if more use a thinner hook

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch chain

Rs right side

Tr treble

St stitch

Dc double crochet

Blo insert hook into back loop only

Ss slip stitch

Beg beginning

Yrh yarn round hook

Rept repeat

Rnd round

Special Abbreviations

Tr2tog (yrh, insert hook in next st, yrh and pull up loop, yrh and draw through 2 loops) twice, yrh and draw through all loops on hook

NOTES

Cardigan is a loose fitting garment. Fronts, Back and Sleeves are worked separately from the bottom up. All pieces except sleeves are worked in rows. Cuffs are worked in rows, then the sleeves are worked in rounds on the cuff row-ends. When changing yarn, change colour on last yrh of last st in previous yarn colour

BACK

Using yarn A, ch94[100:106:112].

Row 1: (rs) Tr into 4th ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn. 92[98,104,110] tr]

Row 2: Ch3 (counts as first tr throughout) tr in each st to end, turn.

Row 3: Ch3, tr2tog, tr to last 3 sts, tr2tog, tr in last st, turn. 90[96,102,108] sts

Rows 4 – 7: As row 2

Rows 8 – 27: Rept last 5 rows 4 times more. 82[88,94,100] tr

Rows 28 – 39: Work (Row 3, then 3 rows as row 2) 3 times. 76[82,88,94] tr

Rows 40 – 43: (Row 3, Row 2) twice. 72(78,84,90) tr
Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Using yarn A, ch47[50,53,56].

Row 1: (rs) Tr into 4th ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn.45[48,51,54] tr

Row 2: Tr into 4th ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn.

Row 3: Ch3, tr2tog, tr in each st to end, turn. 44[47,50,53]tr

Rows 4 – 7: As row 2

Row 8: Ch3, tr to last 3 sts, tr2tog, tr in last st, turn. 43[46,49,52] tr

Rows 9 – 12: As row 2

Row 13 As row 3. 42[45,48,51] tr

Rows 14 – 17: As row 2

Row 18: As row 8.

41[44,47,50] tr

Rows 19 – 22: As row 2

Row 23: As row 3.

40[43,46,49] tr

Rows 24 – 27: As row 2

Shape Neck

Row 28: Ch3, tr2tog, tr to last 3 sts, tr2tog, tr in last st, turn. 38[41,44,47] tr

Rows 29 – 31: As row 2

Rows 32 – 35: Rept last 4 rows once more. 36[39,42,45] tr

Rows 36 – 43: Work (row 28, row 2) 4 times. 28[31,34,37] tr
Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Using yarn A, ch47[50,53,56].

Row 1: (rs) Tr into 4th ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn.45[48,51,54] tr

Row 2: Ch3, (counts as first throughout), **tr in each st to end, turn.**

Row 3: Ch3, tr to last 3 sts, tr2tog, tr in last st, turn. 44[47,50,53] tr

Rows 4 – 7: As row 2

Row 8: Ch3, tr2tog, tr in each st to end, turn. 43[46,49,52] tr
Complete as for Left Front to end, referring to row 3 and row 8 as set for Right Front in repeats.

SLEEVES

The cuff is worked back and forth in rows, then joined to form a tube.

Main part of Sleeve is worked into row-ends of Cuff in the round.

CUFF

Using yarn A ch,14

Row 1:(rs) dc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn. 13 dc

Row 2: Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), dc in blo to end, turn.

Rept row 2 until there are a total of 25[25,25,30] rows.
Fasten off leaving a long tail and whip stitch to sew the last row to the foundation ch to join into a tube.
Fasten off.

MAIN SLEEVE

Work in rounds, turning after every round. Join 2 strands of yarn A in seam of Cuff with rs facing, ready to work in row-ends of Cuff.

Rnd 1:(rs) Ch1, dc in each row-end of Cuff, ss to beg dc, turn. 25[25,25,30] dc

Rnd 2: Ch3 (counts as first tr throughout), tr in same dc, 2tr in each dc around, ss to top of beg ch-3, turn. 50[50,50,60]tr.

Rnd 3: Ch3, tr in same st, tr in next st, (2 tr in next st, 1 tr) around, ss to top of beg ch-3, turn. 5[75,75,90] tr

Rnds 4 – 7: Ch3, tr in each st around, ss to top og beg ch-3, change to yarn B on last yrh of last st of rnd7, turn.

Rnds 8 – 11: Rept rnd 7, changing colour at end of each rnd, using following sequence: Yarns B, C, D and E.

Rnds 12 – 15: Rept last 4 rnds once more.

Rnds 16 – 17: Ch3, tr in each st around, ss to top of beg ch-3, turn.

Rnd 18: Ch3, 2tr, tr2tog, (3tr, tr2tog) around, ss to top of beg ch-3, turn. 60[60,60,72] tr
Cont working in Yarn A as rnd 16 until sleeve measures 43 cm from beg. Fasten off.

FINISHING OFF

Join seam at shoulders, matching Fronts and Back.

Sew in sleeves. Join underarm and sleeve seams.

Using yarn A, work 1 row of dc around front edges and neck.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

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
