



**CY1164 CYGNET DK 'UDDERLY' LOVEABLE COW

## Materials

1 x 100g Cygnet DK White 208 (MC)  
1 x 100g Cygnet DK Black 217 (CC1)  
1 x 100g Cygnet DK Flash 159 (CC2)

4mm Crochet Hook

Safety Toy stuffing

Safety Toy Eyes: 5mm & 10mm

Stitch Marker

Tapestry Needle

## Tension

Tension is not important as long as you maintain the same tension throughout.

## Sizing

Approx. 25 cm tall.

## Abbreviations

**This pattern is written in UK Crochet terms**

Rnd Round

Ch Chain

St Stitch

Dc Double Crochet

Dc2tog Work 2 dc stitches together; Insert hook in to next st, yo, pull yarn through, then insert hook in to next stitch, yo, pull through, yo, pull through three loops on hook.

Slst Slip Stitch

**Place a stitch marker at the beginning of each row so you don't lose your place.**

### Body

With 4mm hook and MC.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: \*dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: \*dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)

Rnd 6: \*dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)

Rnd 7: \*dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 8: \*dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 9: \*dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnd 10: \*dc into next eight sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (60sts)

Rnd 11: \*dc into next nine sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (66sts)

Rnds 12 & 13: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 14: \*dc into next ten sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (72sts)

Rnds 15-16: Dc in to each st.

Rnd 17: \*dc into next eleven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (80sts)

Rnds 18-29: Dc into each st.

Rnd 30: \*dc into next eleven sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (72sts)

Rnds 31-33: Dc into each st.

Rnd 34: \*dc into next ten sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (66sts)

Rnds 35-37: Dc into each st.

Rnd 38: \*dc into next nine sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (60sts)

Stuff, and continue to stuff as you go.

Rnd 39: Dc into each st.

Rnd 40: \*dc into next eight sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (54sts)

Rnd 41: Dc into each st.

Rnd 42: \*dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (48sts)

Rnd 43: Dc into each st.

Rnd 44: \*dc into next six sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (42sts)

Rnd 45: Dc into each st.

Rnd 46: \*dc into next five sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)  
Rnd 47: Dc into each st.  
Rnd 48: \*dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)  
Rnd 49: Dc into each st.  
Rnd 50: \*dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)  
Rnd 51: \*dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (12sts)  
Rnd 52: \*dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (6sts)  
Fasten off leaving a long thread.

Tip: Don't overstuff the top of the body as this will prevent the head resting correctly on it.

### Head

With 4mm hook and CC2.  
Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)  
Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)  
Rnd 3: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)  
Rnd 4: \*dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)  
Rnd 5: \*dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)  
Rnd 6: \*dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)  
Rnd 7: \*dc into next five sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (42sts)  
Rnd 8: \*dc into next six sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (48sts)  
Rnd 9: \*dc into next seven sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (54sts)  
Rnds 10-12: Dc in to each st.  
Change to MC.  
Rnds 13-24: Dc in to each st.  
Rnd 25: \*dc into next seven sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (48sts)  
Rnd 26: Dc in to each st.  
Rnd 27: \*dc into next six sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (42sts)  
Attach the smaller safety eyes for the nostrils in between rows 8 and 9

approx. 2cm apart. Attach one of the large eyes between rows 24 and 25. (the other eye will be attached later as part of the eye patch)  
Stuff, and continue to stuff as you go.  
Rnd 28: Dc in to each st.  
Rnd 29: \*dc into next five sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)  
Rnd 30: \*dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)  
Rnd 31: \*dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)  
Rnd 32: \*dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)  
Rnd 33: \*dc, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (12sts)  
Rnd 34: \*dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (6sts)  
Thread yarn through remaining stitches and pull tight.

### Eye Patch

With 4mm hook and CC1.  
Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)  
Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)  
Rnd 3: 5tr, tr, htr, dc into next two sts, tr, dc into next two sts, htr, tr, 5tr, slst into last st and fasten off.

### Feet

Make 4.  
With 4mm hook and CC1.  
Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)  
Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)  
Rnd 3: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)  
Rnd 4: \*dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)  
Rnd 5: \*dc into next three sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)  
Rnd 6: \*dc into next four sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (36sts)  
Rnd 7: Working into the back of stitch only dc in to each st.  
Rnd 8: Dc into each st.  
Change to MC.  
Rnds 9-10: Dc into each st.

Rnd 11: \*dc into next four sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (30sts)  
Rnds 12-14: Dc into each st.  
Rnd 15: \*dc into next three sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)  
Rnds 16-22: Dc into each st.  
Rnd 23: \*dc into next two sts, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)  
Rnd 24: \*dc into next st, dc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd. (12sts)  
Fasten off.  
Stuff.

### White Ear

With 4mm hook and MC.  
Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)  
Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)  
Rnds 3-5: Dc into each st.  
Rnd 6: 2dc, dc into next four sts, 2dc into the next two sts, dc into next four sts, 2dc. (16sts)  
Rnds 7-8: Dc into each st.  
Rnd 9: 2dc, dc into next six sts, 2dc into the next two sts, dc into next six sts, 2dc. (16sts)  
Rnds 10-12: Dc into each st.  
Fasten off.

### Ear with Patch

Follow the steps for the white ear, working Rnds 1-6 in CC1 and Rnds 7-12 in MC.

### Horns

Make 2.  
With 4mm hook and CC2.  
Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)  
Rnds 2-4: Dc into each st.  
Fasten off.

### Udder

Follow the steps for the eye patch, using CC2.

### Small Heart Markings

Make 4.  
Follow the steps for the eye patch, using CC1.

### Large Heart Marking

With 4mm hook and CC1.

Rnd 1: ch2, 6 dc in second ch from hook, join to 1st dc using slst to form a ring. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 2dc into each dc around. (12sts)

Rnd 3: \*dc, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (18sts)

Rnd 4: \*dc into next two sts, 2dc into next st; rep from \* to end of rnd. (24sts)

Rnd 5: 3htc, 5tc, tc into next two sts, htc into next three sts, dc into next three sts, htc, tc, htc, dc into next three sts, htc into next three sts, tc into next two sts, 5tc, 3htc, slst in to last st and fasten off.

### **To Make up**

Attach the castoff edge of the body to the head.

Attach the ears to the head.

Attach the large eye to the eye patch and line up with the other eye already in place on the head and fix in place.

Attach the feet. Attach the udder to the front of the cow and the markings across the back.

For the tail; cut four strands of CC1 and eight strands of MC 20cm long.

Thread the four strands of black yarn through the lower back so the length on each side is equal. Do the same with four of the white strands to one side of the black strands and the other four white strands to the other side.

Platt the three groups of yarn together and use a piece of yarn wrapped around the bottom to secure. Trim the strands to neaten.



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
