## MEASUREMENTS

To Fit Adult

## MATERIALS

2 X 100g balls Folly Garden shade Fern Cone 20202

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

### Tension:

9 sts and 13 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, measured over stocking stitch using 9 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

**VERY IMPORTANT:** IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

### Knitting Needles:

1 pair of 9 mm (UK 00 -US15)

### Abbreviations:

**alt** alternate

**K** knit

**skpo** slip one, k1, pass slipped stitch over

**beg** beginning

**kfb** k into front and back of next st

**st(s)** stitch(es)

**cm** centimetres

**P** purl

**tog** together

**fol** following

**rem** remaining

**tbl** through back of loops

**g** grammes

**rept** repeat

**ws** wrong side

**in(s)** inch(es)

**rs** right side

### Special Abbreviations:

**Stst stocking stitch** (1 row K, 1 row P)

**M1. Make one stitch.** Pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into the back of this loop

**MB. Make Bobble.** [P1,K1,P1,K1] all into next st, pass 2<sup>nd</sup>,3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> sts over 1<sup>st</sup> st and off needle

## RIGHT MITT

Using 9 mm needles cast on 19 sts and work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib. \*\*

Change to 10 mm needles and commence patt as follows:

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** (rs) K

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P12, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P2.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** P13, MB, K1, MB, P3.

### Shape Thumb Gusset

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** (rs) K10, M1, K3, M1, K6. 21 sts.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P14, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P2.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K10, M1, K5, M1, K6. 23 sts.

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** P17, MB, K1, MB, P3.

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** K10, M1, K7, M1, K6. 25 sts.

**6<sup>th</sup> row:** P18, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P2.

### Shape Thumb

**Next row: (rs)** K16, kfb, turn.

**Next row:** P7, kfb, turn

Beg with a K row, work 4 rows in stst on these 9 sts.

**Next row:** [ K2tog, K1]3 times. 6 sts.

**Next row:** [P2tog] 3 times. 3 sts.

Break off yarn, thread through rem sts, pull up tight and fasten off. Use tail end to sew up thumb seam.

### Work Palm

With rs facing, rejoin yarn at base of thumb, pick up and K2 sts from base of thumb and K to end. 20 sts.

**Next row:** P14, MB, K1, MB, P3.

**Next row:** K

**Next row:** P13, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P2.

**Next row:** K

The last 4 rows sett the patt.

Cont in patt for a further 5 rows, ending with a ws row.

### Shape Top

**Next row:** [skpo, K6, k2tog] twice. 16 sts.

**Next row:** P

**Next row:** [skpo, K4, k2tog] twice. 12 sts.

**Next row:** [P2tog, P2, P2togtbl] twice. 8 sts. Cast off. Sew top and side seam.

## LEFT MITT

Work as given for Right Mitt to \*\*

Change to 10 mm needles and commence patt as follows:

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** (rs) K

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P2, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P12.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** P3, MB, K1, MB, P13.

### Shape Thumb Gusset

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** (rs) K6, M1, K3, M1, K10. 21 sts

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** P2, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P14.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K6, M1, K5, M1, K10. 23 sts

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** P3, MB, K1, MB, P17.

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** K6, M1, K7, M1, K10. 25 sts.

**6<sup>th</sup> row:** P2, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P18.

### Shape Thumb

**Next row:** K13, kfb, turn.

**Next row:** P7, kfb, turn.

Beg with a K row, work 4 rows in stst on these 9 sts.

**Next row:** [ K2tog, K1]3 times. 6 sts.

**Next row:** [P2tog] 3 times. 3 sts.

Break off yarn, thread through rem sts, pull up tight and fasten off. Use tail end to sew up thumb seam.

**Work Palm**

With rs facing, rejoin yarn at base of thumb, pick up and K2 sts from base of thumb and K to end. 20 sts.

**Next row:** P3, MB, K1, MB, P14.

**Next row:** K

**Next row:** P2, [MB, K1] twice, MB, P13.

**Next row:** K

These 4 rows set the patt

Cont in patt for a further 5 rows, ending after s ws row.

**Shape Top**
