Cushions  
Boho Spirit

**Measurements and Materials**

**Crochet Cushion**

2 x 100gm balls Cygnet Boho Spirit shade Breeze 6517

Crochet hook size 4.00mm. Cushion pad size 36 x 36 cm. 4 buttons

**Knitted Cushion**

2 x 100gm balls Cygnet Boho Spirit shade Sapphire 6334

A pair of needles size 4.50mm. Cable needle. Cushion pad size 36 x 36 cm.

## TENSION

**Crochet** 16 tr in width x 8 rows measures 10cm over treble

**Knitting** 22 sts to 10cm when slightly stretched measured over cable pattern

If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle/hook, if more use a thinner needle/hook

## CROCHET CUSHION

### Special Abbreviations

FPT Yrh, insert hook at front of work from right to left under the stem of the tr in the previous row, yrh, draw loop through, complete as normal tr

BPT Yrh, insert hook at back of work from right to left under the stem of the tr in the previous row, yrh, draw loop through, complete as normal tr

### Front

Using 4.00mm hook Make 63 ch

Row 1 : 1tr in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, 1tr in each tr to end. (62 tr)

Row 2 : 1tr in each tr to end

### Begin Pattern

Row 1 : 3ch, 1FPT, 1FPT, \* 1tr in each of next 15tr, FPT twice, 1tr in next tr, FPT twice, rep from \* once, then 1tr in each of next 15tr, FPT, twice, 1tr in top of turning ch of previous row.

Row 2 : 3ch, 1BPT, 1BPT, \* 1 tr in each of next 15tr, BPT twice, 1tr in next tr, BPT twice, rep from \* once more then, 1tr in each of next 15tr, BPT twice, 1tr in turning ch of previous row.

Rows 3-4 : Repeat last 2 rows once more.

Row 5 : 3ch ( counts as first tr ) 1tr in each of next 7tr, FPT twice, 1tr in next tr, FPT twice, 1 tr in each of next 15tr, FPT twice, 1tr in next tr, FPT twice, 1tr in each of next 15tr, FPT twice, 1 tr in each of next 8tr, working last tr in top of turning ch of previous row.

Row 6 : 3ch ( counts as first tr ) , 1tr in each of next 7tr,BPT twice, 1tr in next tr, BPT twice, 1tr in each of next 15tr, BPT twice 1tr in next tr, BPT twice ,. 1tr in each of next 15tr, BPT twice, 1tr in each of next 8 tr, working the last tr in top of turning ch of previous row.

Row 7-8 : as rows 5 and 6. Repeat rows 1-8 twice more. Work Rows 1-4 once more.

Next Row : 3ch, 1tr in each tr to end. Repeat last row once and fasten off.

### Back (worked in two parts)

#### Part 1

Using 4.00mm make 63 ch.

Row 1 : 1tr into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, 1tr into each ch to end. ( 62 tr )

Row 2 : 3ch, ( counts as first tr ), 1tr into each tr to end.

Repeat Row 2 a further 12 times.

Row 15 : 1ch, 1dc into each tr to end.

Row 16 : As Row 15.

Row 17 : ( Make buttonholes ): 1ch, 1dc into each of next 6dc, miss 2dc, \* 1dc into next 14dc, miss 2 dc , rep from \* twice more, 1dc in each of next 6 dc,

Row 18 : 1ch, 1dc into each dc, working 2ch over missed dc of previous row.

Row 20 : 1ch, 1dc into each dc and ch to end.

Row 21 : 1ch, 1dc in each dc to end. Fasten off.

## Part 2

Using 4.00mm hook make 63 ch.

Row 1 : 1tr into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook, 1tr in each ch to end.

Row 2 : 3ch ( counts as first tr ), 1tr in each tr to end.

Repeat Row 2 a further 14 times.

Row 17 : 1ch, 1dc into each tr to end.

Rows 18 -22 : work as Row 17. Fasten off.

## To Assemble

Attach the buttons to correspond with the buttonholes and button the two pieces of the back cushion together. This makes it easier to sew the back and front together.

Pin the back to the front and sew the seams together all around the cushion, overlapping the ends of the buttonhole bands and sewing in place. Unbutton the back and insert the cushion pad.

## KNITTED CUSHION

### Special Abbreviations

TW2 worked over next 2sts : insert needle into front of second st and knit this stitch, do not slip st off needle, now knit the first st in the normal way and slip both stitches off the needle together.

C8R = slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, knit next 4 sts, then knit the four stitches from the cable needle.

C8L = slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, knit next 4 sts, then knit the four stitches from the cable needle.

### Front

Using 4.50mm needles cast on 78 sts

Knit 2 rows.

## Foundation Rows

Row 1 : P4, TW2, P4, TW2, P9, K8, P9, TW2, P9, K8, P9, TW2, P4, TW2, P4.

Row 2 : K4, P2, K4, P2, K9, P8, K9, P2, K9, P8, K9, P2, K4, P2, K4.

Repeat the last 2 rows twice.

## Begin Pattern

Row 1 : : P4, Tw2, P4, TW2, P9, C8R, P9, TW2, P9, C8L, P9, TW2, P4, TW2,P4

Row 2 : K4, P2, K4, P2, K9, P8, K9, P2, K9, P8, K9, P2, K4, P2, K4.

Row 3 : P4, Tw2, P4, TW2, P9, K8, P9, TW2, P9, K8 ,P9, TW2, P4, TW2, P4.

Row 4 : as Row 2.

Rows 5-12 : repeat rows 3 and 4

These 12 rows form pattern and are repeated throughout for 36cm. Cast off.

## Back

Using 4.50mm needles cast on 70 sts. Work in st st for 36cm. Cast off.

## To Assemble

Pin the back and front pieces together right sides facing inside. Sew three sides together with a neat back stitch seam, leave top seam open. Insert the cushion pad. Now close the final seam using mattress stitch to achieve an invisible seam.



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
