KIDDIES COLLECTION DK
BABY DUNGAREES AND HAT

MATERIALS

2 x 100g balls of Cygnet Kiddies Collection DK in Teddy 4166 (MC)

1 x 100g ball of Cygnet Pure Baby DK in White 2080 (CC1)

4 mm Crochet hook, 2 Buttons

MEASUREMENTS

To fit 0-3 months

Hat circumference 40cm

Romper waist 48cm, Romper length 48cm

Abbreviations

Ch chain dc double crochet beg beginning BLO back loops only sl st slip stitch tr treble crochet

tr2tog treble crochet 2 together (decrease) ftr foundation treble crochet

Tension

17 sts x 13 rows measures 10cm x 10cm

ROMPER

Note: Worked from the ankles up, first making each leg then joining to create the body before adding the front and back bibs and finally, the straps. Hat is started at the ribbing then worked up to finish at the crown.

Ankle ribbing:

With CC1, chain 11

Row 1: Beg in 2nd ch from hook, 10 dc. Turn

Row 2-29: 1 ch, in BLO, 10 dc. Turn.

Row 30: (Joining the start to finishing edge to form a ring) 1 ch, insert hook in back loops of row 29 AND in stitch at starting chain edge for each stitch, 10dc.

Turn to work along the row ends, 30 sl st around the circumference of the cuff to provide stitches for the leg to be worked into.

Leg:

Round 1: With MC, 3 ch (does not count as st here and throughout), working into the slip stitches around the edge of the cuff (2 tr, 2 tr in next st) 10 times, sl st to first tr to join. 40 sts

Rnd 2-17: 3 ch, 40 tr, sl st to join. 40 sts

Fasten off, make second leg the same. Do not fasten the second leg off

Body:

Rnd 18: Place both legs together, sl st into the first stitch of the previously fastened off leg to join the two together, 3 ch, 40 tr around one leg, then 40 tr around the other, sl st to first st to join. 80 sts

Rnd 19-30: 3ch, 80 tr, sl st to join. Fasten off.

Front Bib

Row 1: Lay the piece so far flat. Count in 8 stitches from the edge, rejoin MC at 9th stitch, 3 ch, 24 tr, turn (leaving remaining sts unworked).

Row 2-10: 3 ch, 24 tr, turn.

Row 11: 3 ch, 3 tr, 3 ftr, miss 3 sts, 12 tr, 3ftr, miss 3 sts, 3 tr. (This row creates the buttonholes)

Row 12: 3 ch, 24 tr.

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Back Bib

Miss 16 sts on round 30 of body, rejoin MC at 17th st

Row 1-12: 3 ch, 24 tr, turn

Edging

Rnd 1: Join CC1 on the back of the romper where the waist edge meets the back bib. Slip stitch evenly around the entire top edge (up the side of the bib, across the top, down the other side of the bib, along the waist, up, over and down the front bib and along the final waist section).

Rnd 2: dc into each slip stitch, sl st to first dc to join, fasten off and weave in ends.

Straps

Row 1: With back of the garment facing, rejoin CC1 at the stitch in the top right corner of the back bib, 1 ch, 6 dc, turn.

Row 2-40: 1 ch, 6 dc. Fasten off weave in ends.

Repeat this in the 6 stitches at the top left of the back bib.

Pocket

With MC, chain 23

Row 1: Beg in 3rd ch from hook, 20 tr.

Row 2-10: 3 ch, 20 tr. Fasten off, leaving long tail end for sewing onto body.

Making up

Weave in all ends on main body. With tapestry needle and CC1, using photographs as a guide, embroider a snowflake on the pocket using chain stitch. Fasten off and weave in ends. Using tail end, sew pocket onto front of romper. Sew a button onto the end of each strap.

HAT

Ribbing

With CC1, chain 11

Row 1: Beg in 2nd ch from hook, 10 dc. Turn

Row 2-71: 1 ch, in BLO, 10 dc. Turn.

Row 72: (Joining the start to finishing edge to form a ring) 1 ch, insert hook in back loops of row 71 AND in stitch at starting chain edge for each stitch, 10dc.

Turn to work along the row ends, 72 sl st around the circumference of the rib to provide stitches for the main hat piece to be worked into.

Rnd 1-7: With MC, 3 ch, 72 tr, sl st to join.

Rnd 8: 3 ch, (4 tr, tr2tog) 12 times, sl st to join. 60 sts

Rnd 9: 3 ch, (3 tr, tr2tog) 12 times, sl st to join. 48 sts

Rnd 10: 3 ch, (2 tr, tr2tog) 12 times, sl st to join. 36 sts

Rnd 11: 3 ch, (tr, tr2tog) 12 times, sl st to join. 24 sts

Rnd 12: 3 ch, tr2tog 12 times, sl st to join. 12 sts

Fasten off, leaving long tail end. Weave the tail end in and out of the final round of stitches and draw up tightly to close crown. Fasten off securely.

With CC1 sew a snowflake onto the front of the hat to match the one on the Romper, using chain stitch.

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
