



## CY1807 CYGNET YETI CHUNKY SNUGGLE SHAWL

### **Materials –**

6 mm crochet hook

Cygnet Yeti Chunky -

2 balls of Snowberry 2065 – yarn A

1 ball of Frosted Flurry 2043 – yarn B

2 balls of Spritzer 2098 – yarn C

Large eye sewing needle

### **Pattern notes -**

UK terminology used -

The beginning chain 4 counts as the 1st treble crochet and chain 1

Cluster stitch – work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch or space

**Abbreviations -**

tr – treble crochet	st(s) – stitch(s)	cl - cluster
ch(s) – chain(s)	t – turn your work	bet – between
sk – skip	fo – fasten off yarn	sp(s) – space(s)
	nxt – next	slst – slip stitch

Row 1 – with yarn A make a magic ring, ch 4, into ring work cl + ch 1 + tr, tighten ring, fo A (1 cl)

Row 2 – with B ch 4, t, into ch 1 sp, ch 1 cl, ch 1, into last sp cl + ch 1 + tr (2 cl)

Row 3 – ch 4, t, [ into ch 1 sp, cl, ch 1] 2 times, into last cl + ch 1 + tr, fo B (3 cl)

Row 4 – with C, ch 4, t, [ into ch 1 sp, cl, ch 1] 3 times, into last cl + ch 1 + tr (4 cl)

Row 5 – ch 4, t, [ into ch 1 sp, cl, ch 1] 4 times, into last cl + ch 1 + tr, fo C (5 cl)

Row 6 – with A ch 4, t, [ into ch 1 sp, cl, ch 1] 5 times, into last cl + ch 1 + tr (6 cl)

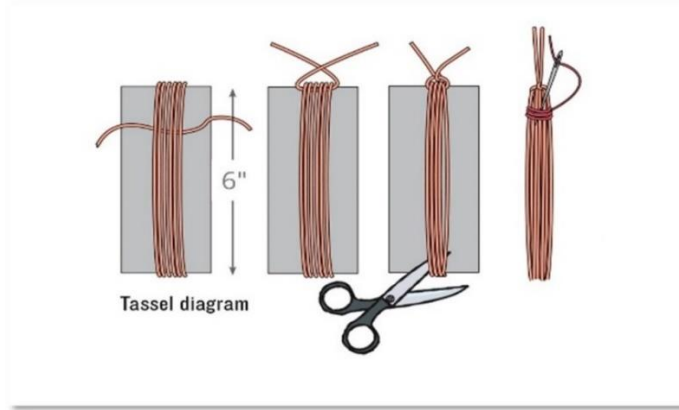
Continue in this fashion until you have worked a total of 44 rows, making 1 additional cluster every row.

Following the colour pattern of 1 row in A, then 2 rows of B and C

**To make tassels –**

Make 3 and attach 1 to each of the 3 corners

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6 “ in height
- Cut 6 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 15 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top. to attach to the shawl on all 3 corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the centre to blend them in
- Trim Neatly
