



CY1807 CYGNET YETI CHUNKY SNUGGLE SHAWL

Materials -

6 mm crochet hook

Cygnet Yeti Chunky -

2 balls of Snowberry 2065 - yarn A

1 ball of Frosted Flurry 2043 - yarn B

2 balls of Spritzer 2098 - yarn C

Large eye sewing needle

Pattern notes -

UK terminology used -

The beginning chain 4 counts as the 1st treble crochet and chain 1

Cluster stitch – work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch or space


Abbreviations -	st(s) - stitch(s)	cl - cluster
tr – treble crochet	t – turn your work	bet – between
ch(s) – chain(s)	fo – fasten off yarn	sp(s) - space(s)
sk – skip	nxt – next	slst – slip stitch

Following the colour pattern of 1 row in A, then 2 rows of B and C

To make tassels -

Make 3 and attach 1 to each of the 3 corners

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6 " in height
- Cut 6 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 15 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top. to attach to the shawl on all 3 corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the centre to blend them in
- Trim Neatly





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
