



CYGNET 100% COTTON DK LADIES GRANNY SQUARE SWEATER

Materials and Measurements

4 mm crochet hook

Pattern notes -

Yarn used - Cygnet 100% cotton DK

Yarn A – 7 balls – Vanilla Cream 2156

Yarn B - 1 ball - Spring 6711

Yarn C – 1 ball – Peony Pink 4065

- Yarn D 1 ball Pearl Grey 6808
- Yarn E 1 ball Golden 3184
- Yarn F 1 ball Lagoon 5331

Yarn G - 1 ball – Frosty Blue 5033

UK terminology used

UK size 10 to 12

Neck 56 cm, chest 80 cm, length 60 cm.

Abbreviations explained -

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch

Cluster - work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch or space.

- Ch 3 counts as 1st treble crochet
- Ch 4 counts as a treble crochet and chain 1

Abbreviations -

tr – treble crochet cl(s) - cluster(s) dc – double crochet vst – v stitch htr – half treble crochet t – turn your work ch(s) - chain(s)sk – skip

st(s) - stitch(s)

fo - fasten off yarn nxt – next

bet - between

tur – turning

sp(s) - space(s)

cor - corner

Granny squares -

Full squares –

Make 16 in Pearl grey and Golden

Make 12 in Lagoon and Frosty Blue

Make 8 in Spring and Peony Pink

Row 1 – with yarn B/D/F, Ch 4, slst to join into a ring, ch 3, into ring work 2 tr, [ch 2 + cl] 3 times, ch 2, slst to top ch 3, fo

Row 2 – attach yarn C/E/G, into ch 2 cor sp, ch 3, into sp work 2 tr + ch 2 + cl, [ch 1, into nxt cor sp work cl + ch 2 + cl] 3 times, ch 1, slst to top ch 3, fo

Row 3 – attach yarn A into cor ch 2 sp, ch 3, into sp work 2 tr + ch 2 + cl, [ch 1, into ch 1 sp, work a cl, ch 1, into cor sp work cl + ch 2 + cl] 3 times, ch 1, into ch 1 sp, work a cl, ch 1, slst to top ch 3

Row 4 – slst into cor sp, ch 3, into sp work 2 tr + ch 2 + cl, [ch 1, into ch 1 sp, work a cl, ch 1, into ch 1 sp work a cl, ch 1, into cor sp work cl + ch 2 + cl] 3 times, [ch 1, into ch 1 sp, work a cl, ch 1, into ch 1 sp work a cl, ch 1, slst to top ch 3, fo

Half squares –

Make 4 in Lagoon and frosty blue

Row 1 – with yarn B/D/F, Ch 4, slst to join into a ring, ch 3, into ring work 3 tr + ch 2 + 4 tr, fo

Row 2 – in yarn C/E/G, ch 3, t, cl into base of ch, ch 1, into ch 2 sp work cl + ch 2 + cl, ch 1, into last tr work 4 tr, fo

Row 3 - in yarn A ch 3, t, cl into base of ch, ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp, ch 1, into ch 2 sp work cl + ch 2 + cl, ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp, ch 1, into last tr work 4 tr


Row 4 – ch 3, t, cl into base of ch, [ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp] twice, ch 1, into ch 2 sp work cl + ch 2 + cl, [ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp] twice ch 1, into last tr work 4 tr, fo

Joining squares – make 2 panels the same

Following the graph below, line up your squares with the right sides facing inward.

Using yarn A, attach into the corner space of the 1st 2 squares, ch 1, going through both layers dc into the ch 2, sp, dc into each of the nxt 3 tr, dc into the ch 1 sps, rept across.

Continue in this fashion until you have joined rows 1 to 4 across, and then 5 to 7 vertically.



Side section -

Attach yarn A into the bottom cor ch 1 sp, you will be working towards the armpit.

Row 1 - ch 4, * cl into nxt available sp, ch 1 *, rept from * to * 18 more times

Row 2 – ch 3, t, [cl into next available sp, ch 1] 18 times, ending with 2 tr into the last sp and 1 tr into the 3^{rd} ch

Row 3 – rept row 2

Fasten off and rept for the opposite side

Repeat for the other panel

Joining –

Line up both panels with right side facing inward and dc join as before.

Sleeves –

Attach yarn A into one of the cor sps on the sleeve section Row 1 – ch 1, cl into 1^{st} sp, ch 1, cl into nxt till you have worked 15 clu sts, slst to 1^{st} st Row 2 – ch 1, t, cl into each sp around, slst to 1^{st} st Rept row 2 in the following colour changes

(15 cl)

** 1 row in B

1 row in C

- 2 rows in A
- 1 row in D
- 1 row in E
- 2 rows in A
- 1 row in F
- 1 row in G
- 2 rows in A **
- Rept ** to ** one more time
- 1 row in B
- 1 row in C
- 2 rows in A

Sleeve trim –

Row 31 - Ch 1, work 1 * dc into each of the tr sts of the cl, sk the ch 1, sp, rept from * around, slst to 1st st Rows 32 to 36 – ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1st st.

Waist trim -

Attach A into any ch 1 sp on the back

Row 1 - Ch 1, work 1 * dc into each of the tr sts of the cl, 1 dc into the ch 1, sp, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Rows 2 to 7 - ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1st st.

Neck trim -

Attach A into the back centre st

Row 1 - Ch 1, work approx. 2 dc around each of the ch sps, rept all the way around, slst to 1st st

Rows 2 to 8 - ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1^{st} st.

Weave in all ends.
