CYGNET BOHO SPIRIT STACKED V STITCH SHAWL

Materials-

4.5 mm crochet hook

2 x 100g balls of Cygnet Boho Spirit in Lotus 6006 – yarn A

1 x 100g ball of Cygnet Everyday Pato in Black 975 – yarn B

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

Chain 4 - the turning chain 4 counts as the first treble crochet of the row + chain 1

V stitch – treble crochet + chain 1 + treble worked into the same stitch or space

Cluster – 3 treble crochet worked into the same stitch or space

Abréviations –

tr – treble crochet
 dc - double crochet
 htr – half treble
 crochet

vst – v stitch
 cl – cluster stitch
 ch(s) - chain(s)
 chsp- chain space
 t - turn your work

nxt – next
 rept - repeat
 sk - skip
 sp(s) - space(s)
 cor – corner

slst – slip stitch
 fo – fasten off

Body -

With Yarn A make a magic ring or alternatively ch4 and slst to join into a ring.

- Row 1 – ch 4, into ring work a cl, + ch 1 + tr (1 cl)
- Row 2 – ch 4, t, into chsp work cl, ch 1, into last sp work cl + ch 1 + tr (2 cl)
- Row 3 – ch 4, t, into chsp work cl, ch 1, [cl into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 1, into last sp work cl + ch 1 + tr (3 cl)
- Row 4 – ch 4, t, into chsp work vst, ch 1, [vst into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 2, into last sp work vst + ch 1 + tr (4 vst)
- Row 5 – ch 4, t, into chsp work vst, ch 1, [vst into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 3, into last sp work vst + ch 1 + tr (5 vst)
- Row 6 – ch 4, t, into chsp work vst, ch 1, [vst into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 4, into last sp work vst + ch 1 + tr (6 vst)
- Row 7 – ch 4, t, into chsp work cl, ch 1, [cl into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 5, into last sp work cl + ch 1 + tr (7 cl)
- Row 8 - ch 4, t, into chsp work cl, ch 1, [cl into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 6, into last sp work cl + ch 1 + tr (8 cl)
- Row 9 - ch 4, t, into chsp work cl, ch 1, [cl into nxt chsp, ch 1] x 7, into last sp work cl + ch 1 + tr (9 cl)

Continue increasing as above working 3 rows of v stitches and 3 rows of cluster stitches till you have used the 2 balls of yarn.

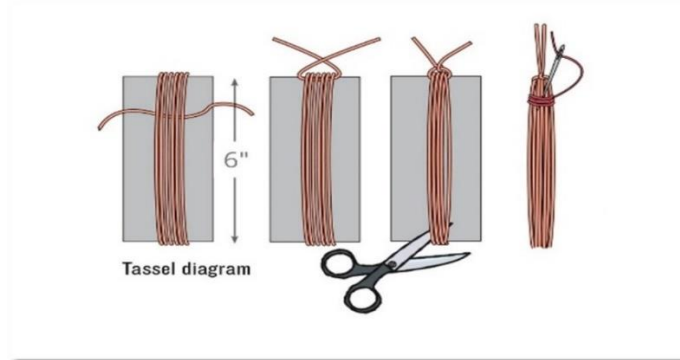
Fo yarn A and attach yarn B

Black trim – working down the side

Row 1 – ch 1, dc, ch 3 sk over the cl and dc into the nxt sp *ch 3, sk chsp, dc into nxt*, rept from * to * till you reach the point, dc + ch 3 + dc into the top stitch, rept from * to * till the end, dc into last st

Row 2 – ch 1, t, work all the way along adding 1 htr into each dc and 2 htr around every ch 3 sp adding a htr + ch 2 + htr into the point stitch

Fo and weave in all ends.



To make tassels – with Yarn B

Make 3 and attach 1 to each of the 3 corners

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6 “in height
- Cut 6 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 20 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top. to attach to the shawl on all 3 corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the centre to blend them in
- Trim Neatly

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
