## Marshmallow Duo Jelly Baby Chenille

### Measurements

13cm wide x 18cm tall (with legs)

### Materials

Yarn A – 100g Cygnet Jelly Baby Chenille Blush (002)

Yarn B – 100g Cygnet Jelly Baby Chenille White (001)

Yarn C – 30g Cygnet Jelly Baby Chenille Teddy (013)

Yarn D – Small amount of any Black DK

Stuffing

4 x 12mm Safety Eyes

Black Thread

**crochet hook:** 4mm

## Abbreviations

<b>ch</b>	Chain	<b>dc</b>	Double Crochet	<b>inv dec</b>	Invisible Double Crochet Decrease
<b>mc</b>	Magic circle	<b>ss</b>	Slip Stitch	<b>*..*</b>	Repeat instructions between asterisks
<b>st</b>	Stitch	<b>inc</b>	Double Crochet Increase	<b>BLO</b>	Back Loop Only

Place a stitch marker at the start of each row so you don't lose your place.

## Body (Yarn A or B)

With 4mm hook and Yarn A or B make a mc.

**Round 1:** 8dc into magic circle (8 sts)

**Round 2:** \*inc\* x 8 (16sts)

**Round 3:** \*inc, 1dc\* x 8 (24sts)

**Round 4:** \*inc, 2dc\* x 8 (32 sts)

**Round 5:** \*inc, 3dc\* x 8 (40 sts)

**Round 6:** \*inc, 4dc\* x 8 (48 sts)

**Round 7:** \*inc, 5dc\* x 8 (56 sts)

**Round 8:** \*inc, 6dc\* x 8 (64 sts)

**Round 9:** In BLO for this round, 64dc (64 sts)

**Rounds 10 - 26:** 64dc (64 sts)

*Between rows 16 & 17 affix the safety eyes, 6 stitches apart. Embroider a smile using Yarn D (or black cotton Yarn), across row 18, approximately 1 stitch tall and 3 stitches wide.*

*(Optional) You can also add 1 stitch of blush to each side of the face in Yarn A.*

**Round 27:** In BLO for this round, 64dc (64 sts)

**Round 28:** \*inv dec, 6dc\* x 8 (56 sts)

**Round 29:** \*inv dec, 5dc\* x 8 (48 sts)

**Round 30:** \*inv dec, 4dc\* x 8 (40 sts)

**Round 31:** \*inv dec, 3dc\* x 8 (32 sts)

**Round 32:** \*inv dec, 2dc\* x 8 (24 sts)

*Add the stuffing into the marshmallow body.*

**Round 33:** \*inv dec, 1dc\* x 8 (16 sts)

**Round 34:** \*inv dec\* x 8 (8 sts)

*sl st into the next stitch and fasten off, leaving a tail to sew close the body. Sew closed the body.*

## Legs x 2

With 4mm hook and Yarn C ch 4.

**Round 1:** inc, 1dc, 2 inc, 1dc, inc (10 sts)

**Round 2:** inc, 1dc, 6 inc, 1dc, inc (18 sts)

**Round 3:** 18dc (18 sts)

**Round 4:** 3dc, 6 inv dec, 3dc (12 sts)

**Round 5:** 3dc, 3 inv dec, 3dc (9 sts)

**Round 6 - 9:** 9dc (9 sts)

*Sl st and fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing the leg closed and sewing onto the body.*

### **Assembly**

Stuff each leg with a little bit of stuffing. Using the tail you left when fastening off, sew closed each leg, do not cut off, you will need to sew the legs to the body.

Sew the legs to the edge of the bottom of the body, with 8 stitches in between. You can line them up with the outside of the eyes.
