



EASY COWL SWEATER SERIOUSLY CHUNKY CY1963

MEASUREMENTS

Bust Size 32 – 34(36 – 38 and 40 – 42) in 81 – 87 (92 – 97 and 102- 107)cm

Actual Measurement 40(43 and 45) in 102(109 and 114)cm

MATERIALS

Cygnets Seriously Chunky shade Unicorn 3364 12[13-14] 100g balls

A pair of 10 mm knitting needles

9.00 mm crochet hook

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = continue

K = Knit

Inc = increase

P = Purl

Patt pattern

Rem = Remaining

Rept = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = together

WS = Wrong side

TENSION

10 sts and 12 rows to 10cm [4 in] measured over pattern on 10mm needles

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS

IF YOUR TENSION SQUARE IS TOO SMALL THEN USE A LARGER NEEDLE, IF IT'S TOO LARGE USE A SMALLER

NEEDLE

NOTE The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one set of figures is given this applies to all sizes.

TECHNIQUE

Beaded Rib Stitch

1st row (RS) * P2, K1, P1, K1, rept from * to last 2 sts, P2.

2nd row K2, * P3, K2, rept from * to end.

Rept rows 1 and 2 for patt

BACK

Cast on 52[57,62]sts and work in Beaded Rib Stitch Pattern

for 56[57,58] cm, ending with 2nd row.

Cast off 17[19,22] sts in patt at beg of next rows.

Cast off rem 18[19,18] sts.

Rept last 2 rows once more.

Work 7 rows straight on these 17[19,22]sts. Cast off.

With rs facing, cast off centre 10[11,10] sts and patt to end.

Complete to match first side of neck reversing shapings

COLLAR

Cast on 62 sts and work 11cm in patt as given for Back end with a 1st row.

Next row (Make eyelet holes) K2, [yarn round needle, P2tog, P1, K2] 12 times. Cast off loosely.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until 12 rows less have been worked than on Back, ending with rs facing for next row.

Shape Neck

Next row Patt 21[23,26] turn and work on these sts only.

Next row P2tog, patt to end.

Next row Patt to last 2 sts, k2tog.

SLEEVES (Both alike)

Cast on 17[22,22] sts loosely.

Work in patt as given for Back, inc one st at each end of every 4th row to 37[44,46]sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 43[45:45] cm, or length required.

Cast off loosely.

FINISHING OFF

Join shoulder seams.

Fold sleeves in half and placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam, sew in sleeves. Join and sleeve seams.

Pin collar in place all around neck opening ensuring that the right side is facing outwards,

sew in place, positioning seam at one shoulder and ensuring the eyelet holes are at the top edge.

Make a Twisted cord or a Tie Cord by working a length of

crochet chains using 9.00 mm hook. Thread through eyelet holes.

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
