



CY1335 Cygnet Chunky Willow Hat & Cowl

You will need

5.5 - and 6-mm crochet hooks

2 x 100g balls of Cygnet Chunky Willow 515

Fur pom pom * or you can create your own pompom with left over yarn

Darning needle

Pattern Notes

UK terminology used

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.

When working the slip stitches, be sure to make them loose, or you may struggle to work into them on the following row.

Abbreviations

htc – half treble crochet	dc – double crochet	rept - repeat	nxt - next
htc2tog – half treble crochet 2 together	blo – back loop only	st(s)– stitch(s)	sp(s) – space(s)
	ch - chain	rem – remaining	fo – fasten off
	slst - slip stitch	t - turn your work	

Hat

Brim – With your 5.5 mm hook, ch 9

Row 1 – dc into 2nd ch, dc into each ch across (8)

Rows 2 till 56 – ch 1, t, dc into 1st st, dc blo into nxt 6 sts, dc into last st

Line up edges and going through both layers, slst together.

Body

Turn the right way out and change to 6 mm hook.

Row 57 – ch 1 and work 1 dc into the end of every row on the brim, slst to 1st dc (56)

Row 58 – ch 1, t, htc into 1st, slst into nxt, rept across, slst to 1st htc

Row 59 – ch 1, t, htc into every slst and htc across

Row 60 to 71 – rept rows 58 and 59, 6 more times

Row 72 – rept row 58

Row 73 – ch 1, t, * htc, htc2tog, rept from * across (38)

Row 74 – rept row 58

Row 75 – rept row 73 (26)

Row 76 – rept row 58

Row 77 – ch 1, t, htc2tog, rept across (13)

Row 78 – ch1, t, htc2tog 6 times, htc into last (7)

Fasten off leaving a small tail for sewing the gap.

Sew your small gap closed and attach pom pom.

Cowl

With your 6mm hook ch 22

Row 1 – htc into 2nd ch, htc in each ch across (21)

Row 2 – ch 1, t, htc into 1st, slst into nxt, rept across

Row 3 – ch 1, t, htc into every slst and htc, rept across

Rept rows 2 and 3 - 43 more times.

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Fold your cowl over going through both layers, sew together the 2 outer edges as outlined below.

Fasten off and weave in all ends.



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
