



CY1504 Cygnet Pure Baby DK
Rainbow Dreams Baby Blanket

Measurements

Size: approx. 67 x 81cm

Materials

Cygnet Pure Baby DK
Cream (2191) – 100g x2
Lilac (2113) – 100g x1
Ocean (2464) - 100g x1
Peppermint (2021) – 100g x1
Lemon (2131) – 100g x1

Peach Blossom (2424) – 100g x1

Petal Pink (2124) – 100g x1

Hook – 4.5mm

Scissors

Tapestry/Wool Needle

Notes

- Patterns written in UK Terms.
- This is an interlocking shell stitch blanket and there are some video tutorials on YouTube, just search for Interlocking shell stitch.
- Ch1 at the beginning of each row DOES NOT count as a stitch.
- The cream yarn is carried up the side of your blanket.
- Turn at the end of each row.

Abbreviations

CH – Chain

SS – Slip Stitch

STS – Number of stitches

DC – Double Crochet

HTR – Half Treble Crochet

TR – Treble Crochet

TR5TOG - Treble Crochet Decrease over 5 stitches

() – All stitches done in the same stitch

INC – Increase

Tension

16 stitches x 11 rows (4 inch square)

Pattern

To Start – 4.5mm hook, In Cream chain 123

Row 1

In 3rd chain from the hook (counts as a stitch), 2tr inc, *skip 2, dc, skip 2, 5tr inc* repeat * * to the last 6 stitches, skip 2, dc, skip 2, 3tr inc in the last chain, turn [19 shells, 2 half shells].

Note – Don't break cream yarn, leave hanging and carry up the side of your blanket.

Row 2 – Join Lilac

Ch1, *dc, ch2, tr5tog, ch2* repeat * * to the last stitch, dc, turn [20 shells]

Row 3

Ch1, 3tr, *dc (in middle of tr5tog from previous row), 5tr inc* repeat * * to the last stitch, 3tr, turn [19 shells, 2 half shells] Break yarn.

Repeating Pattern	
Row 4 – Cream – Repeat row 2	Row 13 – Cream – Repeat row 3
Row 5 – Ocean – Repeat row 3	Row 14 – Peach Blossom – Repeat row 2
Row 6 – Ocean – Repeat row 2	Row 15 – Peach Blossom – Repeat row 3
Row 7 – Cream – Repeat row 3	Row 16 – Cream – Repeat row 2
Row 8 – Peppermint – Repeat row 2	Row 17 – Petal Pink – Repeat row 3
Row 9 – Peppermint – Repeat row 3	Row 18 – Petal Pink – Repeat row 2
Row 10 – Cream – Repeat row 2	Row 19 – Cream – Repeat row 3
Row 11 – Lemon – Repeat row 3	Row 20 – Lilac – Repeat row 2
Row 12 – Lemon – Repeat row 2	Row 21 – Lilac – Repeat row 3

Rows 22 - 75

Repeat the above repeating pattern sequence and colour changes 3 more times.

Row 76

In **Cream** repeat row 2.

Don't Break yarn.



Border

To Start – turn your blanket

Round 1 – In **Cream** (still attached) htr evenly across the top of your blanket (approx. 101 sts), in the last stitch (htr, ch1, htr) this will be your first corner, now htr evenly down the edge of your blanket (approx. 118 sts), in the last stitch (htr, ch1, htr) this will be your second corner, now htr evenly across the bottom of your blanket (approx. 101 sts), in the last stitch (htr, ch1, htr) this will be your third corner, now htr evenly down the last edge of your blanket (approx. 118 sts), in the last stitch (htr, ch1, htr) this will be your final corner, ss to first htr made.

Round 2 – Attach **Lilac** to any ch1 space in a corner, ch1, (htr, ch1, htr) this will be your first corner, htr in each stitch to the next corner, (htr, ch1, htr) repeat around your blanket to the end, ss to the first htr made.

Repeating Pattern
Round 3 – Ocean – Repeat round 2
Round 4 – Peppermint - Repeat round 2
Round 5 – Lemon - Repeat round 2
Round 6 – Peach Blossom – Repeat round 2
Round 7 – Petal Pink - Repeat round 2

Round 8 – Attach **Cream** to any ch1 space in a corner, ch1, *dc, skip 2, 5tr inc, skip 2* repeat * * around your blanket to the last stitch, ss to the first stitch made.

Break yarn, sew all ends in.
