



CY1853 CYGNET MARSHMALLOW PIES STACKED V STITCH SHAWL

Materials-

4.5 mm crochet hook

1 x 150g yarn cake of Cygnet Marshmallow Pies in Graffiti Sweetie 1200 – yarn A

1 x 100g ball of Cygnet Everyday Pato in Cream 998 – yarn B

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

Chain 4 - the turning chain 4 counts as the first treble crochet of the row + chain 1

V stitch – 2 treble crochet worked into the same stitch or space

Peak – v stitch + chain 2 + v stitch worked into the same stitch or space

After row 3 the v stitches will be worked into the centre of the v stitches from the row below

Abbreviations –

tr – treble crochet
 htr – half treble
 crochet
 cor – corner

vst – v stitch
 fptr – front post
 treble crochet
 bptr – back post
 treble crochet

ch(s) - chain(s)
 chsp- chain space
 t - turn your work
 nxt – next
 rept - repeat

sk - skip
 sp(s) - space(s)
 cor – corner
 slst – slip stitch
 fo – fasten off

Body -

With Yarn A make a magic ring or alternatively ch4 and slst to join into a ring.

Row 1 – Into ring work ch4 + 4 tr + ch 2 + 4 tr + ch 1 + tr, tighten ring

Row 2 – ch 4, t, vst into ch 1 sp, tr 4, peak into ch 2, tr 4, vst into last st + ch 1 + tr

Row 3 – ch 4, t, vst into ch sp, [sk 1, vst] x 4, peak into ch 2, [vst, sk 1] x 4, into ch sp vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 4 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 6, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 6, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 5 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 8, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 8, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 6 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 10, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 10, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 7 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 12, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 12, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 8 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 14, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 14, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 9 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 16, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 16, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Row 10 – ch 4, t, vst into vst x 18, peak into ch 2 sp, vst into vst x 18, into last ch sp, vst + ch 1 + tr

Continue increasing as above till you have used all the yarn.

For yarn A and attach yarn B

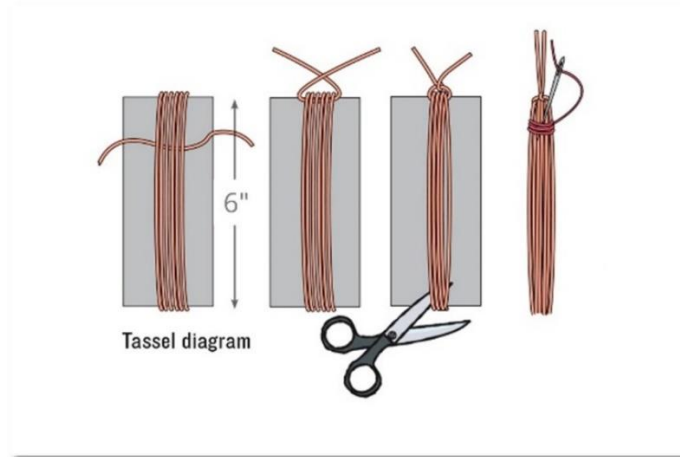
Ribbed trim –

Row 1 – ch 1, htr into each stitch till you reach the peak, 3 htr into the ch 2 sp, htr in each st till the end

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc into 1st, fptr into nxt, bptr into nxt, rept till last st, tr into last

Rows 3 and 4 – ch 1, t, tr into 1st st, fptr into frtr and bptr into bptr, rept till last st, tr into last

For and weave in all ends.



To make tassels – with Yarn B

Make 3 and attach 1 to each of the 3 corners

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6 “in height
- Cut 6 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 20 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top. to attach to the shawl on all 3 corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the centre to blend them in
- Trim Neatly

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
