



CROCHET BABY BONNET

LITTLE ONES DK

CY1989

Materials

Cygnnet Little Ones DK 25g balls (White 999, Cream 998, Black 975 and Dark Brown 979) one ball of each or Cream 998, Pear 967, Grey 978 and Lilac 986

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn sewing needle.

Measurements

To fit baby 6/12 (18/24) months.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches.

Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

TENSION 16 dc and 9 rows = 4" [10 cm].

The instructions are written for 6-12 months. If changes are necessary for the larger size the instructions will be 6/12 (18/24). When only one number is given it applies to both sizes.

SQUARE (make 2) See diagram

With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

1st rnd: Ch 4 (counts as dc. Ch 1). (3 dc. Ch 1) 3 times in ring. 2 dc in ring. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 4. Break A.

2nd rnd: Join B with sl st in next corner ch-1 sp. Ch 4 (counts as dc. Ch 1). 3 dc in same ch-1 sp as sl st. *(3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more. 2 dc in next corner ch-1 sp (same sp as beg ch 4). Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch 4. Break B.

3rd rnd: Join C with sl st in next corner ch-1 sp. Ch 4 (counts as dc. Ch 1). 3 dc in same ch-1 corner sp as sl st. *Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in sp between next 3 dc. Skip next 3 dc ** (3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once. 2 dc in next ch-1 corner sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-4. Break C.

4th rnd: Join D with sl st in next ch-1 corner sp. Ch 4 (counts as dc. Ch 1). 3 dc in same ch-1 corner sp as sl st. *(Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in sp between next 3 dc) to next corner ch-1 sp. Skip next 3 dc ** (3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp. Rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once. 2 dc in next ch-1 corner sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

Work a further 3 (4) rnds as established, working 1 more group of 3-dc before each corner ch-1 sp each rnd, in established colour sequence, beg next rnd with A. Fasten off, leaving long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

With WS tog and sts aligned, sew across 2 sides of Squares using whipstitch to form top and back seams.

BOTTOM EDGING See diagram

Turn Bonnet to work along bottom edge.

1st row: (RS). Join A with sl st in ch-1 sp at right corner. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 21 (24) dc to next ch-1 sp. Sc2tog over next 2 ch-1 sps. 1 sc in each dc to last ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last ch-1 sp. Turn. 45 (51) sts.

2nd to 4th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. Fasten off.

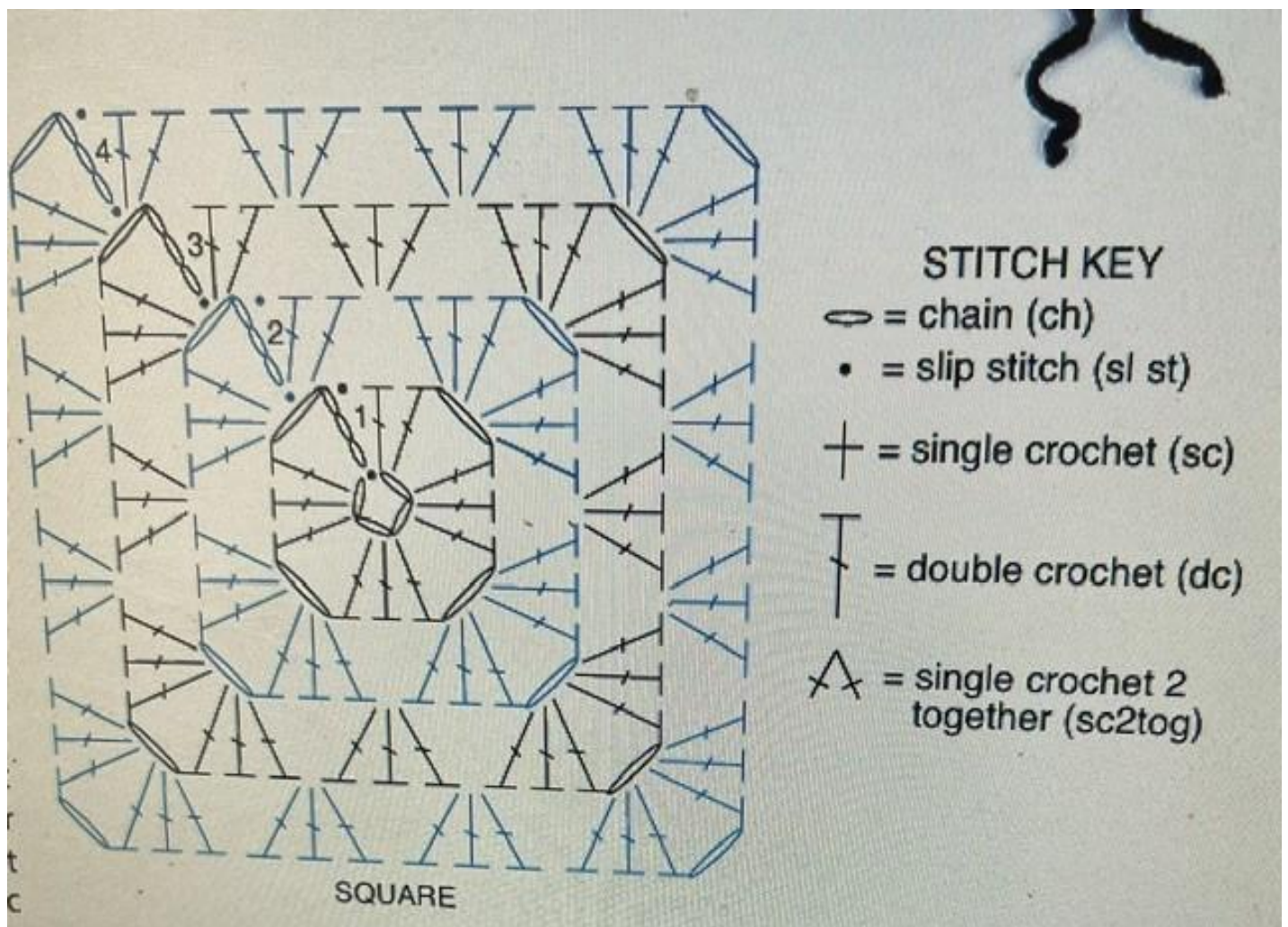
FRONT EDGING AND TIES See diagram

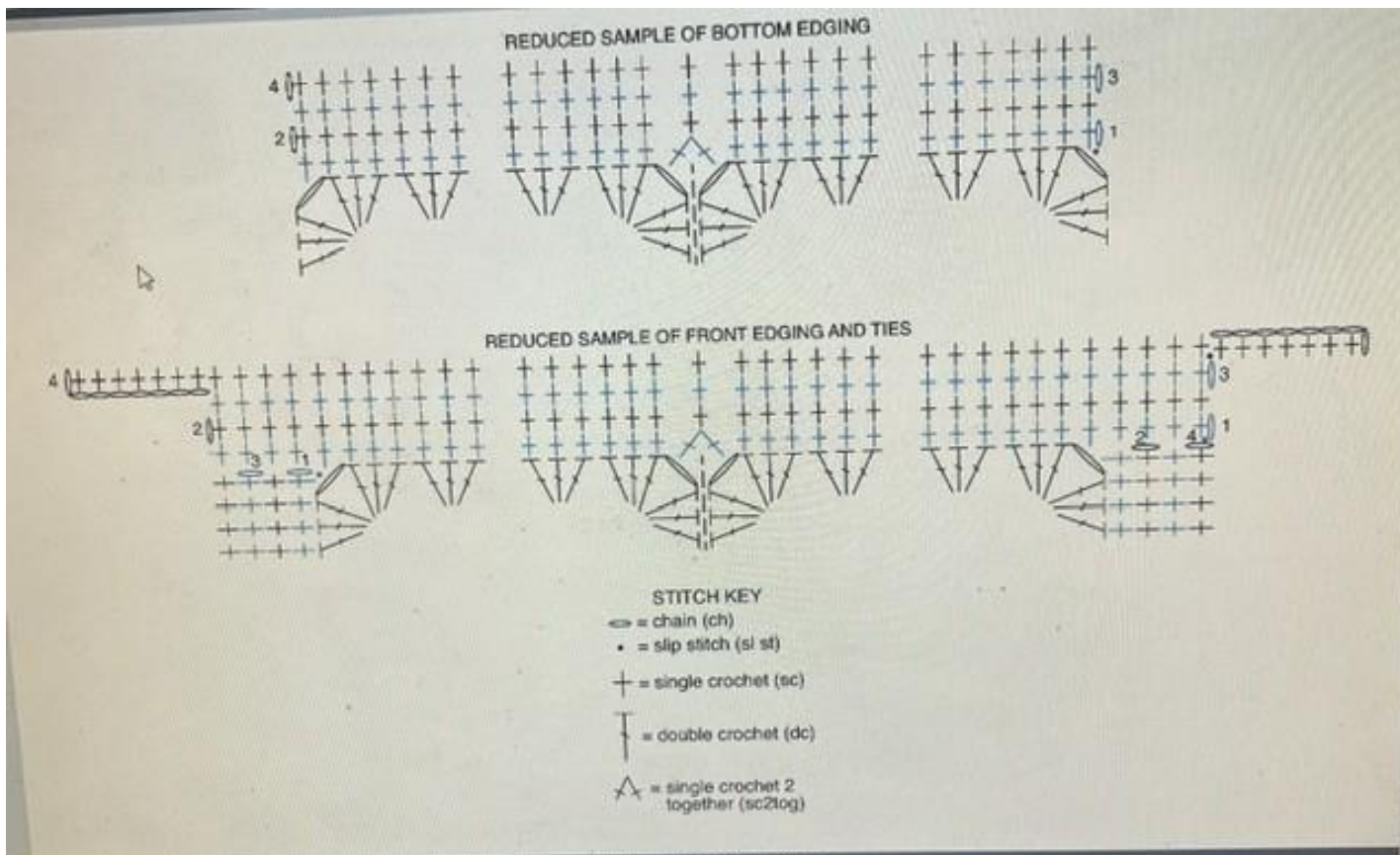
1st row: (RS). Join A with sl st to last sc of last row of Bottom edging. Ch 1. Working into side(s) of last sc of Bottom edge, 1 sc in side of last sc of next 4 rows. 1 sc in each of next 21 (24) dc to ch-1 sp. Sc2tog over next 2 ch-1 sps. 1 sc in each of next 21 (24) dc to Bottom edge. 1 sc into side of last sc of next 4 rows. 51 (57) sts.

2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 29. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 27 ch (first tie made). 1 sc in each st of Front edging to end of row.

Second tie: Ch 29. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 27 ch. Join with sl st into side of last sc of 4th row. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
