



CY1707 Kiddies Supersoft DK and Baby Soft DK

Materials

Kiddies Supersoft DK White (208) Col A 100g 1 ball. Baby Coloursoft DK Roseburst (552) Col B 100g 1 ball. Hook Tension 3.5mm Black safety eyes or small amount of black or embroidery thread for eyes. Stuffing

TENSION is not important so long as it is maintained throughout

ABBREVIATIONS

rnd round sc single crochet ch chain st stitch dec decrease flo front loop only slst slip stitch col colour blo back loop only inc increase dec decrease

I also use the yarn under method rather than the normal yarn over method to make closer stitches.

NOTES TO HELP GET A GOOD FINISH ON YOUR ARIMAGURI:

decrease (dec)- Insert hook through the FLO of the first stitch then the FLO of the second stitch. Yarn under pull through 2 loops. Yarn under pull through 2 loops.

Increase (inc)- sc through both loops, then sc through the FLO of the same stitch.

Use a contrasting colour thread as a stitch marker rather than the traditional stitch markers as they can create holes in your work.

HEAD

Using Col A

Rnd 1: create a magic loop and sc 6 sts into the ring. Pull tight (6sts) Rnd 2: *inc* in each stitch (12sts) Rnd 3: *sc, *inc* in next st* repeat (18sts) Rnd 4: *sc in the next 2 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (24sts) Rnd 5: *sc in the next 3 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (30sts) Rnd 6 - 11: sc in each st (30sts) Rnd 12: *sc in the next 4 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (36sts) Rnd 13: *sc in the next 5 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (42sts) Rnd 14: *sc in the next 6 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (42sts)

NOTE: if using black safety eyes, attach them on Rnd 15 about 8 sts apart.

Rnds 15 - 22: sc in each st. (48sts)

Rnd 23: *sc in the next 6 sts, dec in the next st* repeat (42sts) Rnd 24: *sc in the next 5 sts, dec in the next st* repeat (36sts) Rnd 25: *sc in the next 4 sts, dec in the next st* repeat (30sts) Rnd 26: *sc in the next 3 sts, dec in the next st* repeat (24sts) Rnd 27: *sc in the next 2 sts, dec in the next st* repeat (18sts) Stuff head firmly Rnd 28: *sc in the next st, dec in the next st* repeat (12sts) Rnd 29: dec 6 times (6sts) Rnd 30: dec 3 times (3sts) Leaving a long end, sew in sts to secure

BODY

Using Col A

Rnd 1: create a magic loop and sc 6 sts into the ring. Pull tight (6sts) Rnd 2: *inc* in each stitch (12sts) Rnd 3: *sc, *inc* in next st* repeat (18sts) Rnd 4: *sc in the next 2 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (24sts) Rnd 5: *sc in the next 3 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (30sts) Rnds 6 - 15: sc in each st (30sts) Rnd 16: *sc in the next 4 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (36sts) Rnds 17-18: sc in each st (36sts) Rnd 19: *sc in the next 5 sts, *inc* in the next* repeat (42sts) Rnd 20: *sc in the next 6 sts, inc in the next* repeat (48sts) Rnds 21 - 28: sc in each st (48sts) Rnd 29: *sc in the next 6 sts, dec in the next* repeat (42sts) Rnd 30: *sc in the next 5 sts, dec in the next* repeat (36sts) Rnd 31: *sc in the next 4 sts, dec in the next* repeat (30sts)

Stuff body firmly

Rnd 32: *sc in the next 3 sts, dec in the next* repeat (24sts) Rnd 33: *sc in the next 2 sts, dec in the next* repeat (18sts) Rnd 34: *sc in the next st, dec in the next* repeat (12sts) Rnd 35: dec 6 times (6sts) Sew in sts securely

Attach body to head matching centre bottom of head with centre too of body. Stitch around on Rnd 3 or 4. You may need to add a few sts to the front of the head to prevent it from falling back from the weight of the mane

ARMS (make two)

Beginning with Col A

Rnd 1: create a magic loop and sc 6 sts into the ring. Pull tight (6sts) Rnd 2: *inc* in each stitch (12sts) Rnds 3 - 26: sc in next st (12sts) *Change to Col B*, ensuring you begin with the start of a colour Rnd 27: *sc, *inc* in next st* repeat (18sts) Rnd 28: *sc into the next 2 sts, *inc* in next st* repeat (24sts) Rnds 29 - 33: sc in each st (24sts) Rnd 34: Working through the blo,

*sc in the next 2 sts, *dec** repeat (18sts) Stuff arm but not too firmly were

arm joins body.

Rnd 35: working through both loops *sc in the next st, dec* repeat (12sts)

Rnd 36: dec 6 times (6sts) Sew in the stitches securely

Attach the arms at either side of the neck

LEGS (make two)

sc in each st. (24sts)

Beginning with Col B, ensuring you begin with the start of a colour Rnd 1: create a magic loop and sc 6 sts into the ring. Pull tight (6sts) Rnd 2: *inc* in each stitch (12sts) Rnd 3: *sc in next st, *inc** repeat (18sts) Rnd 4: *sc into next 2 sts, inc* repeat (24sts) Rnd 5: working through the blo,

Rnds 6 - 9: working through both loops, sc in each st. (24sts)
Rnd 10: *sc in the next 2 sts, dec* repeat (18sts)
Rnd 11: *sc in the next st, dec* repeat (12sts)

Change to Col A
Rnds 12 - 35: sc in each st (12sts)

Stuff feet firmly but not as firmly towards the top of the legs

Rnd 36: dec 6 times (6sts)
Sew remaining stitches securely

Attach the legs towards the front of the body to allow the unicorn to sit. Position each leg 3-4 sts from the centre front st and 5 Rnds from the bottom Rnd of body. Stitch in place around the top of the legs.

HORN

Using Col B

Rnd 1: create a magic loop and sc 6 sts into the ring. Pull tight (6sts)
Rnd 2: sc in each stitch (6sts)
Rnd 3: working in the flo *sc, *inc* in next st* repeat (9sts)
Rnds 4 - 5: flo sc in each st (9sts)
Rnd 6: flo *sc in the next 2 sts, *inc** repeat (12sts)
Rnds 7 - 8: flo sc in each sts (12sts)
Rnd 9: flo *sc in the next 2 sts, inc*
repeat (16sts)
Rnds 10 - 11: flo sc in each st (16sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Use remaining yarn to attach the horn to centre of head, approx 4 rnds up from the eyes.

EARS (make two)

Using Col A

Rnd 1: create a magic loop and sc 6 sts into the ring. Pull tight (6sts) Rnd 2: *sc, *inc* in next st* repeat (9sts) Rnd 3 - 6: sc in each st (9sts)

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Use remaining yarn to attach the ears approx 2 sts either side of the horn.

TAIL AND MANE (make 4)

Cut strands in Col B and lay them together with the ends lined up. Trim the other end so all lengths are the same. Fold in half and cut on the fold. Repeat until you are left with a bunch of strands 16 cm in length. Using a white strand, tie around centre of the bunch and secure to form a tassle. Use the yarn ends from the tie to secure in place as follows:

Attach one for the tail at centre lower back so Unicorn is in a sitting position.

Mane: Attach first tassle approx.. 2rnds back from horn. Attach 2nd tassle 2rnds down from here and third tassle 2 rnds down from the second one.



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
