



# **CY1749 Jellybaby Chenille Chunky**

Childs hooded scarf with pockets

## Materials -

4 x 100g Balls of Jellybaby Chenille Chunky in Butterscotch 010

8mm Crochet Hook

Large eye Darning Needle

### Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used

Use this pattern as a guide, you will be prompted when to make the adjustments.

This pattern is an easy 1 row repeat

At the end of the row, turn your work, but don't chain.

Your last stitch of the row should be a treble crochet, which will give you enough room to turn, this helps to keep your edges straight without the need of a border

#### Abbreviations -

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

htr - half treble crochet

slst - slip stitch

st/sts - stitch/stitches

rept - repeat

nxt - next

t - turn

ch - chain

cont - continue

#### **SCARF SECTION**

Chain 13

Row 1 - In 2nd ch from hook dc, \* tr in nxt, dc in nxt, rept from \* across, t

Row 2 - dc in the tr, tr in the dc, rept across, t

Row 3 until desired length - rept row 2

At this point try the scarf on your child, have them stand with their hands down by their side.

The scarf should be long enough to go from fingertips, up across the shoulders down to the other arm to the fingertips. Figure out how deep you want the pockets to be and place markers either side.

Continue to rept row 2 until you have your desired length.

With right sides facing (inside out) place markers at your desired pocket length and whip stitch both edges together. Rept on the other side, turn pockets back out the right way.

#### **HOOD SECTION**

With the wrong sides facing, fold the scarf in half and find the center, place marker.

Count 23 sts to the right and attach yarn

Row 1 - ch1, dc in the 1st, tr in the nxt, cont until you have worked 46 sts, t

Row 2 - dc in the tr, tr in the dc, t

Repeat row 2 until you have the height you want for your hood. 22 rows will give you a nice loose fit as pictured. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

With right sides facing (inside out) line up both edges and place markers along both edges.

Whip stitch both edges together, turn hood back out the right way.

## EARS (make 2)

Ch3, slst to join into a ring

Row 1 - ch1, into the ring work 10 htr, slst to the 1st st

(10)

Row 2 - ch1, 2 htr in every st, slst to the 1st st

(20)

Row 3 - ch1, 2 htr in the 1st st, htr in the nxt, rept around, slst to the 1st st

(30)

Row 4 - ch1, t, dc 24

Row 5 - ch1, t, dc 24

Row 6 - ch1, t, htr 24

Fasten off, attach ears to the hood and weave in ends.





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
