Materials

 $2 \times 100 g$ balls of 3 shades in Cygnet 100% Cotton DK

Pastel version: White 2080 (A), Peach Sorbet 6724 (B) and Frosty Blue 5033 (C) **Bright version:** Ketchup 2209 (A), Peony Pink 4065 (B) and Orange Soda 5506 (C)

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn $\frac{1}{2}$

A pair of 3.75 mm and 4 mm (US5 and US6) knitting needles.

Stitch Holders

TENSION

19 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over pattern on 4 mm needles.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS

If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle, if more use a thinner needle

ABBREVIATIONS

K knit Rept repeat Rs right side
P purl In inches Patt pattern
St(s) stitch(es) Cm centimetres Dec decreasing
Stst stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 Beg beginning Rem remaining row P) Ws wrong side

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

K5B (Knit 5th stitch below)

Slip next st off left hand needle and drop 4 rows down. Insert point of right hand needle under strands and into the st on the 5th row down, insert left hand needle under the strands and into the stitch. Knit the st normally catching the strands at the same time.

BACK and front (Both alike)

Using 3.75 mm needles and A cast on 67[75,83] sts and work 6 cm in K1, P1 rib.

Change to 4 mm needles and commence pattern

Using B, Work 4 rows in stst

Using A, 5th row: K3, * K5B, K3, rept from * to end.

Using C Work 4 rows in stst

Using C Work 4 rows in stst

Using A, 11th row: K1, * K5B, K3, rept from * to last 2 sts, K5B, K1.

Using A, 12th row: Purl.

Rept the last 12 rows until

work measures 23[25,28] cm

from beg ending with a ws

row.

Shape Armholes

Keeping patt correct cast off 11 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 45[53,61] sts. Cont in patt until armholes measure 19 cm ending with a ws row. Shape Neck

Next row: Patt 15[19,23] turn and work on these sts only. Work 4 rows dec one st at neck edge in every row. 11[15,19] sts.

Cont in patt until armholes measure 25 cm ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Next row: Cast off 6[8,10] sts,

K to end.

Next row: P to end.

Next row: Cast off rem 5[7,9]

sts.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, slip next 15 sts to a holder and patt to end.
Work 4 rows dec one st at neck edge in every row. 11[15,19] sts.

Cont in patt until armholes measure 25 cm ending with a rs row.

Shape Shoulders

Next row: Cast off 6[8,10] sts,

P to end.

Next row: K to end.

Next row: Cast off rem 5[7,9]

sts.

NECKBAND

Join left shoulder seam
With rs facing, using 3.75 mm
needles and B, pick up and K17
sts evenly down left side of
neck, k across 15 sts on holder
at centre front, pick up and
K17 sts up right side of neck,
17 sts down right side of back
neck, k across 15 sts on holder
at centre back and pick up and

K16 sts up left side of back neck. 97 sts. Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

ARMBANDS

Join right shoulder and neckband seam.
With rs facing, using 3.75 mm needles and B, pick up and K38 sts from armhole cast off sts

up to shoulder then 37 sts down from shoulder to cast off sts at armhole. 75 sts. Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

FINISHING OFF

Join row ends of armbands to cast off sts at armholes.
Join side seams.
