**The Whopper Cardi**

**NEEDLES**

10mm knitting needles

**NOTIONS**

Sewing needle

**TENSION**

9sts x 10 rows in garter stitch

Whopper Cotton Shocking Pink 667 x 100g	12	13	15

<b>K3tog</b> Knit 3 stitches together	<b>K</b> Knit
<b>P</b> Purl	
<b>WS</b> Wrong Side	

## THE WHOPPER CARDI

### BACK

1. Cast on 46 (55, 64) sts using the long-tail cast on technique. Work in 1x1 rib for 9 rows.
2. Work in garter st until your work measures 55 (60, 65) cm from the cast on edge. Cast off.

### FRONT

1. Cast on 18 (22, 26) sts using the long-tail cast on technique. Work in 1x1 rib for 9 rows.
2. Work in garter st until your work measures 55 (60, 65) cm from the cast on edge. Cast off.
3. Repeat steps 1-3 for the other front panel.

### SLEEVES

1. Cast on 40 (46, 51) sts using the long-tail cast on technique. Work in garter st until your work measures 40 (42, 44) cm from the cast on edge.
2. K1, \*K3tog; rep from \* to the end of the row (13, 15, 17 sts)
3. Work in 1x1 rib for 10 rows. Cast off.
4. Repeat steps 1-4 for the second sleeve.

### ASSEMBLY

1. Lay front panels on back panel, WS facing. Seam together at shoulder seams.
2. Match centre of top of sleeve with shoulder seam, and pin sleeve in place, taking care not to

stretch the top of the sleeve. Sew sleeves securely.

3. Fold cardigan so that WS are facing, and seam side seams together from the cuff to the underarm to the hem.
4. Pick up and knit 53 (58, 63) sts up the right front, 12 (14, 16) sts along the back neck, and 53 (58, 63) sts down the left front. Work in 1x1 rib for 5 rows. Cast off.
5. Weave in all ends.
