## Needles

3.25 mm (US 3) and 4 mm (US6)

Other
Tapestry needle Stitch holders

## Tension

22 sts and 28 rows in stocking stitch on 4 mm needles to 10 cm (4 in) square

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

## Abbreviations

$\mathbf{K}$ knit $\mathbf{p}$ purl cm centimetres in inches stst stocking st (1 row $k, 1$ row $p$ ) tog together rs right side ws wrong side tbl through back of loops inc increase dec decrease alt alternate beg beginning rem remaining cont continue

## BACK

Using 3.25mm needles and C, cast on 112[116:120:126:132]sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to end Repeat last row for 6 cm .
Change to 4 mm needles and join in M.
Work 6 rows in stst with C and 6 rows in stst with M , alternating stripe sequence until Back measures 42[43:44:45,46]cm from cast on edge, ending on a WS row.

## Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 102(106:110:116:122)sts.
Dec row (rs): k1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, k2togtbl, k1

Dec row (ws): p1, p2togtbl, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1
Dec 1 st at each end of next row, then on following alt (rs) row ending on a ws row.
94(98:102:108:114) sts **
Cont straight in stst until
Armhole measures
22[23:24:25:26]cm, ending on a

WS row.
Shape Shoulders and back neck
Cast off 9[9:9:10:11]sts at beg of next 2 rows. 76(80:84:88:92) sts.
Next row: cast off
8[9:9:10:10]sts, k
12[12:13:14:14] and turn, leaving rem 56[58:62:64:68]sts on a stitch holder.
Next row: cast off 4 sts, $P$ to end Cast off rem 8[8:9:10:10]sts.
With rs facing slip centre
34[36:38:38:42]sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn and $K$ to end.

Next row: cast off 8 [9:9:10:10]
sts, purl to end
Next row: cast off 4 sts, $K$ to end Cast off rem 8[8:9:10:10]sts.

## FRONT

Work as for Back to **
Cont straight in stst until
Armhole measures 7cm, ending on a WS row.

Divide for Neck
Next row: K47(49:51:54:57) turn
and leave rem sts on a stitch holder.

Work 1 row.
Next row: knit to last 3 sts, k2togtbl, k1

Next row: purl
Rept last two rows until
25[26:27:30:31]sts rem.
Continue straight in stst until
Armhole measures
22[23:24:25:26]cm, ending on a
WS row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off 9[9:9:10:11]sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.
Cast off 8[9:9:10:10]sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 8[8:9:10:10]sts.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to sts on stitch holder, K to end of row.

Work 1 row.
Next row: k1, k2tog, $k$ to end.
Next row: purl
Rept last two rows until
25[26:27:30:31]sts rem.
Continue straight in stst until
Armhole measures
22[23:24:25:26]cm, ending on a RS row.

## Shape Shoulder

Cast off 9[9:9:10:11]sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.
Cast off 8[9:9:10:10]sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 8[8:9:10:10]sts.

## SLEEVES

With 3.25 mm needles and $C$, cast on 60[60:66:66:72]sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to end
Rept last row for 6 cm .
Change to 4 mm needles and continue in stst stripe sequence as given for Back, at same time inc 1 st at each end of $3^{\text {rd }}$ and every following $7^{\text {th }}$ row until there are 92[92:98:98:104]sts. Cont straight in stst until Sleeve measures 48[49:50:51:52]cm, ending on a ws row.

## Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2
rows (82[82:88:88:94]sts).
RS dec: k1, k2tog, knit to last 3
sts, k2togtbl, k1
WS dec: p1, p2togtbl, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1
Rept last two rows once, then RS dec once more.

Work 1 row.
Work RS dec on next row and on 9[9:10:10:11] following alt rows.

Work RS and WS decs for next 10 rows until 34[34:38:38:42]sts remain.

Work 1 row.
Cast off 6[6:7:7:8]sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 22[22:24:24:26]sts.

## NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. Using 3.25 mm needles and using C, with RS facing, pick up and knit 41[43:43:45:45]sts down left front neck, (the last st will be the centre st) place marker, 40[42:42:44:44]sts up right front neck, 3 sts down right back neck, knit across 34[36:38:38:42]sts from stitch holder, pick up and knit 3 sts up left back neck. (121[127:129:133:137]sts).
Work in $1 \times 1$ rib to 3 sts before marker, dec over next 2 sts, K1, (the last st worked is the centre st) slip marker, dec over next 2 sts, rib to end.

Next row: rib to centre st, P1, rib to end.

Repeat last 2 rows for 3 cm . Cast off in rib.

## MAKING UP

Join left shoulder seam including neckband. Join sleeve and side seams.
