



CY1854 CYGNET MARSHMALLOW PIES BIAS SHAWL

Materials –

4.5 mm crochet hook

1 X 150g yarn cake of Cygnet Marshmallow Pies in Grafitti Sweetie 1200 – yarn A

1 x 100g ball of Cygnet Everyday Pato in White 999

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

This shawl is worked diagonally and is started at the shortest side and increases 1 cluster stitch every second row.

Cluster stitch – 3 treble crochet worked into the same stitch or space

Chain 3 - the turning chain 3 counts as the first treble crochet of the row

Chain 4 - the turning chain 4 counts as the first treble crochet of the row + chain 1

Abbreviations –

tr – treble crochet
dc - double crochet
cor – corner

cl – cluster stitch
ch(s) - chain(s)
chsp- chain space
t - turn your work

nxt – next
rept - repeat
sk - skip
sp(s) - space(s)

cor – corner
slst – slip stitch
fo – fasten off

Body -

With Yarn A make a magic ring or alternatively ch4 and slst to join into a ring.

Row 1 – ch 4, cl, tighten ring (1 cl)

Row 2 – ch 4, t, into sp work cl + ch 1 + tr (1 cl)

Row 3 – ch 4, t, into sp work cl + ch 1, into nxt sp cl (2 cl)

Row 4 – ch 4, t, into sp cl, ch 1, into nxt sp cl + ch 1 + tr (2 cl)

Row 5 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 2 , cl into last sp (3 cl)

Row 6 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 2, into last sp cl + ch 1 + tr (3 cl)

Row 7 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 3, cl into last sp (4 cl)

Row 8 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 3, into last sp cl + ch 1 + tr (4 cl)

Continue to repeat as before increasing at one end

Row 9 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 4, cl into last (5 cl)

Row 10 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 4, into last sp cl + ch 1 + tr (5 cl)

Row 11 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 5, cl into last (6 cl)

Row 12 – ch 4, t, [cl into sp, ch 1] x 5, into last sp cl + ch 1 + tr (6 cl)

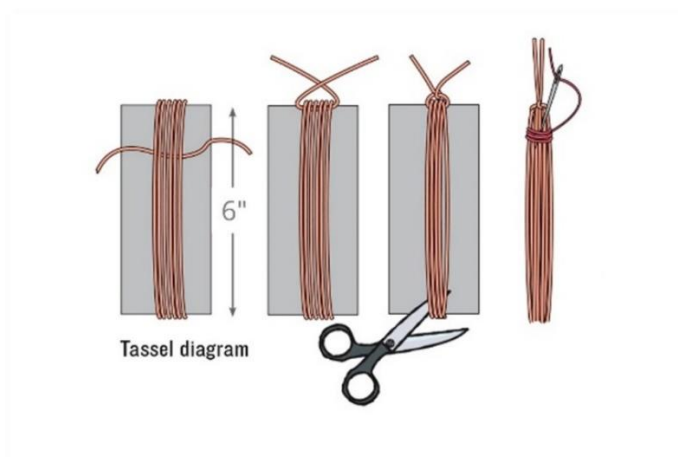
Continue increasing till you have used all of the yarn, fo.

Trim –

Attach yarn B, ch 1 and dc into base of ch

Ch 3, sk over the cl and dc into the ch sp, continue till you reach the cor, dc

Continue as before on the other side finishing with a dc into the last st, fo and follow the directions below to make the 3 tassels.



To make tassels –

Make 3 and attach 1 to each of the 3 corners

- Cut a piece of cardboard 6 “in height
- Cut 6 lengths of yarn, slightly longer than the height of your tassel
- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 20 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 1st length tied at the top. to attach to the shawl on all 3 corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths back down though the centre to blend them in
- Trim Neatly
