Measurements are for 9-12 months up to 2-3 years

## Materials

$\begin{array}{llll}\text { Cygnet Aran } & 2 & 2 & 3 \\ 100 \mathrm{~g} \text { Balls }\end{array}$
Main shade Saffron 488 (M) and 1 ball of Espresso 1182 (C)
3.75 mm (UK 9) and 4.50 mm (UK 7) Needles. Stitch holders. 3 buttons for Sweater. 1 button for Hat.

Tension 19 sts and 40 rows to 10 cm measured over garter stitch on 4.50 mm needles

## IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT MEASUREMENTS

IF TOO SMALL USE A LARGER NEEDLE, IF TOO LARGE USE A SMALLER NEEDLE


#### Abstract

Abbreviations

Sts stitches K knit P Purl cont continue gst garter st (every row $K$ ) cm centimetre in inches beg beginning rept repeat rem remain alt alternate patt pattern rs right side ws wrong side TWR $K$ into front of $2^{\text {nd }}$ st on left hand needle, K into front of first st and slip both loops of together, TWL K into back of $2^{\text {nd }}$ st on left hand needle, K first st and slip both loops off together


## BACK OF SWEATER

Using 3.75 mm needles and C , cast on $50[54,58]$ sts and work 2 rows in K2, P2 rib. Break off C. Join in M and rib 4 more rows. Change to 4.50 mm needles and cont in gst until work measures $17[22,25] \mathrm{cm}$, ending on a ws row.

## Shape Armhole

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 46[50,54]sts.

Cont straight until armholes measure 6[7,8]cm, ending on a ws row.

Divide for Back opening

Next row K25[27,29] turn and work on these sts only.

Work 2 rows straight.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row (make buttonhole) K to last 4 sts, cast off 2 sts, $K$ to end.
$4^{\text {th }}$ row $K$ to end, casting on 2 sts over those cast off in previous row.

Cont straight making the next buttonhole as before on the $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ rows.

Work 6 rows straight
Cast off 12 sts, K to end.

Leave rem 13[15,17] sts on a holder for Neckband.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem $21[23,25]$ sts, cast on 4 sts and complete to match first side, casting off 12 sts at shoulder on opposite edge.

6 $^{\text {th }}$ row P1 K4 P6 K4 P1
$7^{\text {th }}$ row K4 TWR K4 TWL K4
$8^{\text {th }}$ row P1 K3 P8 K3 P1

9 $^{\text {th }}$ row K3 TWR K6 TWL K3
$10^{\text {th }}$ row P1 K2 P10 K2 P1
$11^{\text {th }}$ row K2 TWR K8 TWL K2
$12^{\text {th }}$ row P1 K1 P12 K1 P1
$13^{\text {th }}$ row K1 TWR K10 TWL K1
$14^{\text {th }}$ row P16

These 26 rows form the patt panel

## FRONT

Using 3.75 mm needles and C , cast on $50[54,58]$ sts and work 2 rows in K2, P2 rib. Break off C. Join in M and rib 4 more rows.

Change to 4.50 mm needles and commence patt.
$1^{\text {st }}$ row $\mathrm{K} 4[5,6]$ work $1^{\text {st }}$ row of patt panel for next 16 sts K10[12,14] sts for centre, work $1^{\text {st }}$ row of patt panel for next 16 sts, K4[5,6].
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row row $\mathrm{K} 4[5,6$ ] work 2 nd row of patt panel for next 16 sts K10[12,14] sts for centre, work

2nd row of patt panel for next 16 sts, K4[5,6].

Cont in patt as set working diamond patt from $3^{\text {rd }}$ row of patt panel and repeating the 26 rows until Front measures same as Back to armhole.

## Shape Armhole

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 46[50,54]sts.

Cont straight until 2 complete diamond panels have been worked. Now cont in g st until armholes measure $6[7.5,7.5] \mathrm{cm}$ ending on a ws row.

## Shape Neck

Next row K19[21,22] turn and work on these sts only.

Work $7(9,10)$ rows dec one st at neck edge in every row. 12sts. Work straight until Front matches Back to shoulder.

Cast off.

With right side facing, slip first $8[8,10]$ sts to a holder at centre front and rejoin yarn, $K$ to end.

Complete to match first side of neck.

## SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 3.75 mm needles and C , cast on $30[30,34]$ sts and work 2 rows in K2, P2 rib. Break off C. Join in M and rib 4 more rows.

Change to 4.50 mm needles and commence patt.
${ }^{\text {1st }}$ row $\mathrm{K} 7[7,9]$ work $1^{\text {st }}$ row of patt panel for next 16 sts, K7[7,9].
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row $\mathrm{K} 7[7,9]$ work 2 nd row of
patt panel for next 16 sts $\mathrm{K} 7[7,9]$.
Cont in patt as set working diamond patt up the sleeve from $3^{\text {rd }}$ row of patt panel and repeating the 26 rows at same time inc one st at each end of next every foll $8^{\text {th }}$ row taking inc sts into $g$ st until there are $42[46,54]$ sts. Work without further shaping until Sleeve measures 19[21,24]cm or length required from beg ending on a ws row.

Place a marker at each end of last row.

Work 4 more rows in patt.

Cast off loosely.

## NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams.

With rs facing and using 3.75 mm needles and $M$, $K$ across $13[15,17]$ sts on back holder, pick up and K13[13,14] sts down left front neck, K across $8[8,10]$ sts at centre front, pick up and K13[13,14] sts up right front neck and $K$ across $13[15,17]$ sts on other back holder. 60[64,72]sts.

Work 1 row in K2 P2 rib, keeping 3 sts at each end in g st.

Work last buttonhole in next 2 rows.

Break off M and join in C. Rib 2 more rows. Cast off.

## FINISHING OFF

Insert sleeves from markers and join to cast off sts on Back and Fronts. Join side and sleeve seams.

Using C, work a neat edging oversewing around each buttonhole. Sew on buttons

Using M and 3.75 mm needles cast on $78[82,90]$ sts and work 9 cm in K2, P2 rib.

Change to 4.50 mm needles and continue in K2, P2 rib until Hat measures 13[15,17]cm

## Shape Crown

!st row Rib 6[8,7] * K2tog, Rib $5[5,6]$ rept from * to last 2[4,3] sts, $\operatorname{Rib} 2[4,3]$. 68[72,80] sts.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ and every alt row Rib to end
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row Rib 6[8,7] * K2tog, Rib $4[4,5]$ rept from * to last 2[4,3] sts, Rib $2[4,3]$. 58[62,70] sts.
$5^{\text {th }}$ row Rib 6[8,7] * K2tog, Rib $3[3,4]$ rept from * to last $2[4,3]$ sts, Rib 2[4,3]. 48[52,60 sts.
$7^{\text {th }}$ row Rib 6[8,7] * K2tog, Rib $2[2,3]$ rept from * to last $2[4,3]$ sts, Rib 2[4,3]. 38[42,50 sts.
$9^{\text {th }}$ row Rib 6[8,7] * K2tog, Rib $1[1,2]$ rept from * to last $2[4,3]$ sts, Rib 2[4,3]. 28[32,40] sts.
$\mathbf{1 1}^{\text {th }}$ row Rib 6[8,7] * K2tog, rept from * to last $2[4,3]$ sts, Rib $2[4,3]$. $18[22,24]$ sts.
$12^{\text {th }}$ row * K2tog, rept from * to end. $9[11,12]$ sts.

Break off yarn, thread through remaining sts and fasten off.

Join back seam.

Using 3.75 mm needles and C, cast on 14 sts and work 12 rows in g st. Cast off. Attach to inside edge of brim as in photo and secure with a button.
