



## CY1473 100% Cotton DK Bucket Bag

2 x 100g balls of Cygnet 100% Cotton in 6849 Pistachio (A)

2 x 100g balls of Cygnet 100% Cotton in 6718 Pansy (B)

4mm hook

Size: Base 16cm diameter, height 24cm

## **Abbreviations**

beg beginning

BLO back loops only

ch chain

ch-sp chain space

dc double crochet

sl st slip stitch

st(s) stitch(es)

Pattern is written in UK terms

Note: To create a stiff fabric for the bag, two strands of yarn are held together throughout this pattern, whilst still working with a 4mm hook.

## Bag

Rnd 1: With two strands of A held together (use both balls at once), working into a magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in each st. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: (dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 18 sts.

Rnd 4: (2 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 24 sts

Rnd 5: (3 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 30 sts

Rnd 6: (4 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 36 sts

Rnd 7: (5 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 42 sts

Rnd 8: (6 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 48 sts

Rnd 9: (7 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 54 sts

Rnd 10: (8 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 60 sts

Rnd 11: (9 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 66 sts

Rnd 12: (10 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 72 sts

Rnd 13: (11 dc, 2 dc in next st) 6 times. 78 sts

Rnd 14: In BLO, dc around. 78 sts

Rnd 15-26: dc around.

Rnd 27-48: with B, dc around.

Rnd 49: (to make eyelet holes) (4 dc, 2 ch, miss 2 sts, 5 dc, 2 ch, miss 2 sts) 6 times.

Rnd 50: dc into each st, and 2 dc in each 2ch-sp. 78 sts

Rnd 51-52: dc around.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Strap:

With B, chain 5

Row 1: Beg in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 4 dc. Turn

Row 2-180 (or until strap measures approx 130cm): 1 ch, 4 dc. Turn

Fasten off, use tail ends to sew ends of strap in place on opposite sides of the bag, being careful not to twist.

Cord:

Use A to make an icord as follows:

3 chain. Insert hook into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and pull up a loop, insert hook into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook.) \*CAREFULLY drop the front two loops off the hook, yarn over, pull through loop remaining on hook, put hook back into next loop, yarn over, pull through st, put hook back in third loop, yarn over, pull through st. You should now have 3 loops on hour hook again. Repeat from \* until cord measures approx 90cm. To fasten off, yarn over and pull through all three loops. Weave in ends, and then thread the cord in and out of the eyelets around the top of the bag and tie in a bow.
