Sugar Spun Shawl

## Measurements

Finished blanket measures 100 cm x 100 cm

## Materials

Cygnat Sugar Spun 100g – (A) Cotton Slub 3880 x 1 ball, (B) Fluffy Cloud 3330 x 1 ball, (C) Floating Island 3110 x 1 ball, (D) Orange Fuzz 3770 x 1 ball, (E) Cotton Candy 3440 x 1 ball

5mm crochet hook

## Abbreviations

<b>ch</b>	Chain	<b>tr</b>	treble stitch	<b>ss</b>	slip stitch
<b>st</b>	Stitch	<b>mc</b>	magic circle/magic ring	<b>dc</b>	double crochet

## Notes

Tension is not essential for this pattern. The suggested hook size should create a nice drape, if you think it feels too loose or too stiff go up or down a hook size.

The pattern for this shawl is simple, each row is worked in the same way. Colours are changed to create the design and then a border is added as the last row.

Follow the sequence listed for colour changes.

## Pattern

Using yarn A, create a mc, work into this for row 1 and then pull firmly to close.

**Row 1:** ch 3, 2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr into the mc, change colour, turn.

**Row 2:** ch 3, 2tr into base of ch 3, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into ch 2 space, 3tr into top of last st, change colour, turn.

**Row 3:** ch 3, 2tr into base of ch 3, 3tr into next space, (3tr, ch 2, 3tr) into ch 2 space, 3tr into next space, 3tr into top of last st, change colour, turn.

Repeat Row 3 from now on, working 3tr in each space, changing colours at the end of rows as per the 'Colour Change Sequence' chart. At the end of Row 40, change colour to E, turn and then you will add the border.

## Border

Using E, ch 3, \*3tr into next space, ch 3, dc into next space, 3 ch; repeat from \* until you reach the centre point of the shawl, (dc, ch 3, 3tr, ch 3, dc,) into ch 2 space, ch 3, repeat from \* until you reach the end of the row, slip stitch to the top of the last stitch to finish, fasten off and sew in ends.
