



CY1769 HALLOWEEN BAT YETI

MEASUREMENTS

9.5in/24cm

MATERIALS

1x 100g ball of Cygnet Yarns Yeti in Spritzer 2098

1x 100g ball of Cygnet Yarns Yeti in Blue Mountain 2109

Stitch Marker

Crochet Hook: 5mm

Safety Eyes: 24mm

Felt Mouth: 2.4" (or you could use embroidery thread to sew a smile)

Scissors

Darning Needle

Polyester Filling

Tension

Tension is not important as long as the same tension is maintained throughout.

Abbreviations

This pattern is written in US Terms.

MR – Magic Ring

CH- Chain

SC- Single Crochet

INC - Increase (2 Sc in the same stitch)

RND - Round

DEC – Decrease (Insert hook into 1st stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, then insert hook into next stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, then yarn over and pull through all loops on your hook)

() — Total Stitch Count at end of round.

SL ST - Slip Stitch

F/O – Fasten Off.

Head/Body (This is worked in continuous rounds)

- 1. In Spritzer yarn working into a MR, make 6SC. (6)
- 2. INC (12)
- 3. SC1, INC (18)
- 4. SC2, INC (24)
- 5. SC3, INC (30)
- 6. SC4, INC (36)
- 7. SC5, INC (42)
- 8. SC6, INC (48)
- 9 23. SC around. (48)
- 24. SC6, DEC (42)
- 25. SC5, DEC (36)
- 26. SC4, DEC (30)
- 27. SC3, DEC (24) **Add eyes, mouth and start stuffing**
- 28. SC2, DEC (18)
- 29. SC1, DEC (12)
- 30. DEC x 6, SL ST, F/O. (6)

Ears (Make two)

- 1. MR, 4SC (4)
- 2. SC, INC (6)
- 3. INC (12)
- 4. SC around (12)
- 5. SC around (12)

F/O and leave length of yarn for sewing.

Wings. (Make two in Spritzer and two in Blue Mountain) Make Blue Mountain ones first.

- 1. CH 13. In the 2nd CH from Hook SC 12. CH 1, Turn (12)
- 2. 10 SC, CH 1 and turn. (10)
- 3. 10 SC, CH 1 and turn. (10)
- 4. 8 SC, CH1 and turn. (8)
- 5. 8 SC, CH1 and turn. (8)
- 6. 6 SC, CH 1 and turn (6)
- 7. 6 SC, CH 1 and turn (6)
- 8. 4 SC, CH 1 and turn (4)

9. 4 SC, CH 1 and turn (4)

F/O the Blue Mountain wings, but **don't** fasten off the Spritzer wings. Instead keep yarn attached and pick up a blue mountain wing, hold them together and single crochet around. This will attach the two different coloured wings together. There's no stitch count for this, just crochet around and then join with a SL ST. F/O and leave long tail of yarn for sewing.

Assembly.

Place and sew the ears on top of the head. Place and sew the wings in line with the eyes. Glue or sew on Mouth.

Some Tips for working with Faux Fur Yarn.

This is a lovely yarn, but it can be difficult to see your stitches, so I recommend:

- Count each stitch as you make it.
- Feel your stitches and you will know where to place your crochet hook.
- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round, then move accordingly.



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
