



CYGNET YETI CHUNKY POCKET PILLOW CY1806

Materials –

6 mm crochet hook

2 balls each of Cygnet Yeti Chunky in

Avalanche 2001 – yarn A

Spritzer 2098 – yarn B

45cm x 45cm cushion pad

Stitch markers or safety pins

Large eye sewing needle

UK terminology used -

The beginning chain 3 counts as the 1st treble crochet of the row.

The beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch.

Corner – 2 treble crochet + chain 1 + 2 treble crochet worked into the same stitch or space.

Beginning corner – chain 3 + 1 treble + chain 1 + 2 treble crochet all into the same stitch or space.

Abbreviations -

tr – treble crochet

cor(s) – corner(s)

bcor – beginning corner

htr – half treble crochet

ch(s) – chain(s)

sk – skip

st(s) – stitch(s)

t – turn your work

fo – fasten off yarn

nxt – next

bet – between

sp(s) – space(s)

slst – slip stitch

With Yarn A ch 5

Row 1 – into ring, ch 4, [tr, ch 1] 7 more times, slst to 3rd ch

Row 2 – slst into ch 1 sp, ch 3, tr into same sp, ch 1, 2 tr into the remaining 7 ch 1 sps, slst to 1st st, fo A

Row 3 – attach B into bcor into the nxt 7 ch sps, work a cor, slst to 1st st

Row 4 – slst into ch 1 sp, into 1st st work bcor, * tr into the sp bet cors, cor into ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st st, fo B

Row 5 – attach A into ch 1 sp, into 1st sp work bcor, *1 tr into the space either side of the tr, cor into ch 1 sp, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Row 6 – slst into ch 1 sp, work a bcor, * tr into nxt 3 available sps, cor into ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st st, fo A

Row 7 – Attach B into ch 1 sp, work bcor, * tr into nxt 4 sps, cor into ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

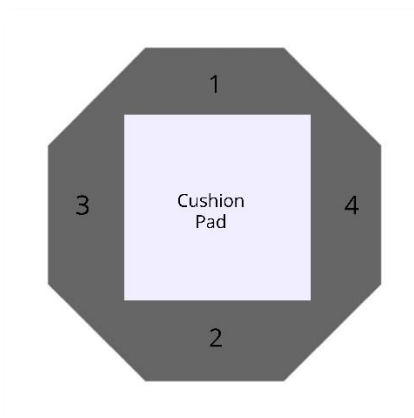
Row 8 – slst into ch 1 sp, work a bcor, * tr into nxt 5 sps, cor into ch 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st st, fo B

Continue working as follows, changing colours after every 2nd row

- Attach your yarn into any corner ch 1 sp and work the bcor
- Work a tr into available sp, increasing by 1 st on each side
- Work a cor into each ch 1
- Rept around and finish by slip stitching into the top of ch 3

Continue until you have worked a total of 20 rows, weave in all ends

Sewing onto cushion pad –



Lay your piece flat with the inside facing upwards and place the cushion in the centre as follows.

Stretch edges 1 and 2 across the cushion and pin the edges together.

Attach yarn into both ch 1 corner spaces and tie to secure.

Sew both edges together using whip stitch, finish off when you reach the opposite ch 1 cor sps.

Rept for sides 3 and 4

Creating Pocket –

Take one of the unsewn edges and pin along the bottom edge.

Attach yarn and working through the stitch, go around the post of the corresponding stitch, and work whip stitch as before, until the panel is secured and your pocket has been created, fo and weave in all ends.



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
