CYGNET CHUNKY  
UNION JACK TEA COSY AND COASTERS

**Materials**

5.5 and 5mm Crochet hooks

1 ball of Cygnet Chunky in

Yarn A – Red 167

Yarn B – Royal 331

Yarn C – White 208

Iron on Union Jack Motif 8 x 5 cm

**Pattern Notes –**

UK terminology used

Tea cosy slips on from the bottom.

Griddle stitch – dc are worked into tr and tr are worked into dc

Tea cosy pattern is worked from the bottom up.

**Abbreviations –**  
dc – double crochet  
tr – treble crochet

ch(s) - chain(s)  
chsp- chain space  
t - turn your work

nxt – next  
rept - repeat  
sk - skip

sp(s) - space(s)  
slst – slip stitch  
fo – fasten off

### Tea Cosy –

With 5.5 mm hook and A – ch 40, slst to form a ring

Row 1 – ch 1, dc into each ch around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st (40)

Row 2 – ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo A, attach B

Row 3 – ch 1, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, \*tr into nxt, dc into nxt, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 4 – ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, tr into nxt, rept around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, , fo B, attach C

Row 5 – ch 1, t, tr into 1<sup>st</sup>, dc into nxt, rept around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 6 – ch 1, t, tr into 1<sup>st</sup>, dc into nxt, rept around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo C, attach A

### First section -

Row 7 – ch 1, t, tr into 1<sup>st</sup>, dc into nxt for the nxt 17 sts (17)

Row 8 – ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, tr into nxt, rept across, fo A, attach B

Row 9 – ch 1, t, tr into 1<sup>st</sup>, dc into nxt, rept across

Row 10 - ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, tr into nxt, rept across, fo B, turn work

### Second section –

On row 6, left of the section you just completed count 5 sts to the left and attach A

Row 11 - ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, tr into nxt for the nxt 17 sts (17)

Row 12 – ch 1, t, tr into 1<sup>st</sup>, dc into nxt, rept across, fo A, attach B

Row 13 – ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, tr into nxt, rept across

Row 14 - ch 1, t, tr into 1<sup>st</sup>, dc into nxt, rept across, fo B, attach C

### Joining –

Row 15 – ch 1, t, work in pattern across the 17 sts, ch 2, on the other side work in pattern for 17 sts, ch 4, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Row 16 – ch 1, t, into the 4 chs work, tr, dc, tr, dc, work in pattern across the 17 sts, into the 2 chs work tr, dc, work in pattern across the 17 sts, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo C, attach A

### Trim -

Row 17 – with 5mm hook, ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st (40)

Rows 18 and 19 – ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo

Attach yarn into the bottom corner of the spout opening, ch 1 and dc evenly around, fo and repeat for handle opening, fo.

Weave in all ends and iron on motif.

### Coasters – make 4

with 5.5mm hook and B ch 15

Row 1 – dc into 2<sup>nd</sup>, \* tr into nxt, dc into nxt, rept from \* across (14)

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc into 1<sup>st</sup>, tr into nxt, rept across, fo

Rows 3 and 4 – with C rept row 2, fo C

Rows 5 and 6 – with A rept row 2, fo A

Rows 7 and 8 – with B rept row 2, fo B

Rows 9 and 10 – with C rept row 2, fo C

### Border -

Attach A, ch 1, dc into each st across till you reach the corner, into corner st work dc + ch 1 + dc, dc evenly down the side, work corner st, rept all the way around, dc + ch 1 into 1<sup>st</sup> st, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo.

Weave in all ends.

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
