



**CROCHET BLANKET  
WHOPPER  
CY1986**

## Materials –

Cygnets Whopper 8 x 200g balls shade 8865

Size 30 mm crochet hook to obtain stated measurement or a larger hook for a larger size.

## Pattern notes

US Terminology used

Ch2 counts as a half double crochet stitch

Turn at the end of each row

Make sure to count the sts after each row at regular intervals

The last st after the 2<sup>nd</sup> row will always be placed on the top ch st of the previous row

## Measurements

Approximately 30 x 42 inches (76 x 107 cm) 25 Chain Stitches

It's easy to make this in a larger size. Use a larger hook and change the length by adding extra rows.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**RS** = Right side

**Beg** = Beginning

**HDC** = Half Double Crochet

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**BLHDC** = Back Loop Half  
Double Crochet

**Patt** = Pattern

**WS** = Wrong side

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Rep** = Repeat

## Special Stitches

**HDC** = yarn over, insert hook through both loops of next st. Yarn over and pull up a loop. ( 3 loops on hook)  
Yarn over once more and pull the loop through all 3 loops on hook.

**BLHDC** = Yarn over, insert hook through back loop of next st. Yarn over and pull up a loop. (3 loops on  
hook) Yarn over once more and pull loop through all 3 loops on hook.

It takes a bit of getting used to working with a big yarn and big hook. Practise makes perfect. Try to get the chain stitches even and looking the same. Your arms and wrists will get a workout!! Take regular breaks

## **Begin**

Make a slip knot and add loop onto crochet hook. Work 25 ch.

**Row 1:** HDC in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook. HDC in each st across. Turn.

**Row 2:** Ch2 (counts as HDC) BLHDC in each st across. End with a HDC in last st. Turn.

**Row 3:** Ch2 (counts as HDC) BLHDC in each st across. End with a HDC in top of Ch of beg Ch2 sts of previous row.

Row 4 and beyond: Rept row 3 for desired length.

## **TO FINISH**

Leave a long length of yarn, pull through last loop on hook. Using your fingers weave through work in different directions. Break off excess yarn.
